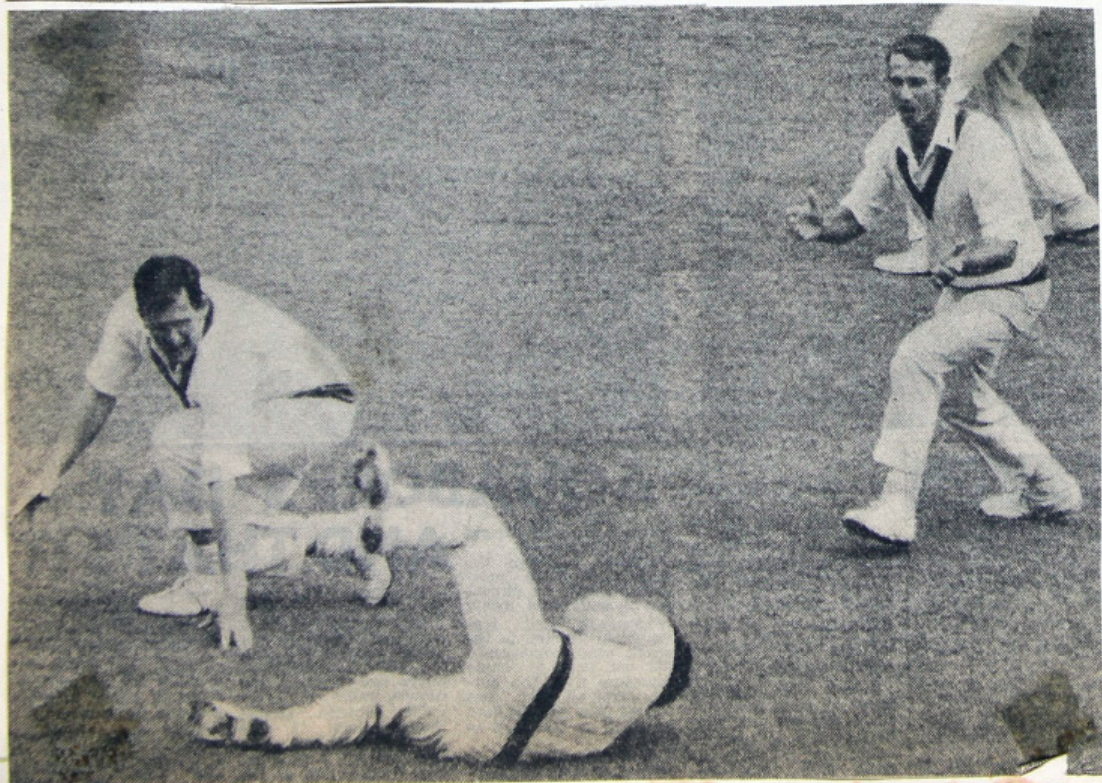

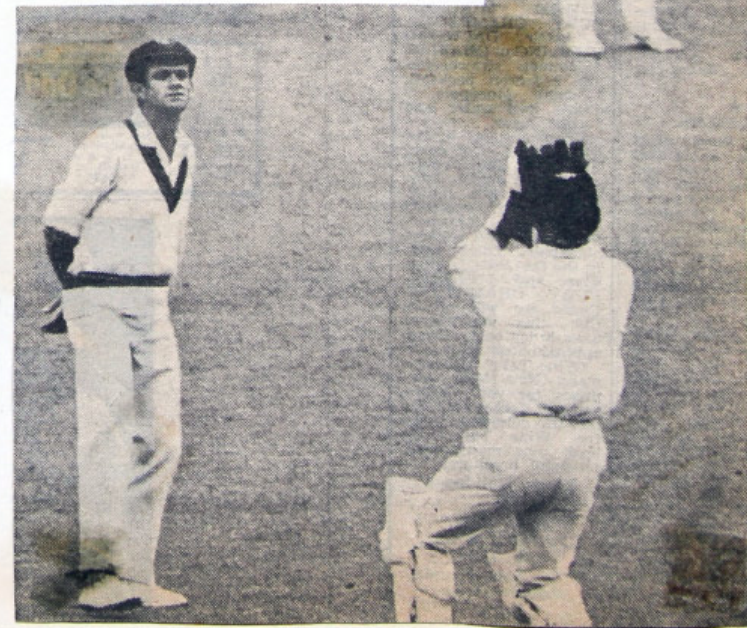

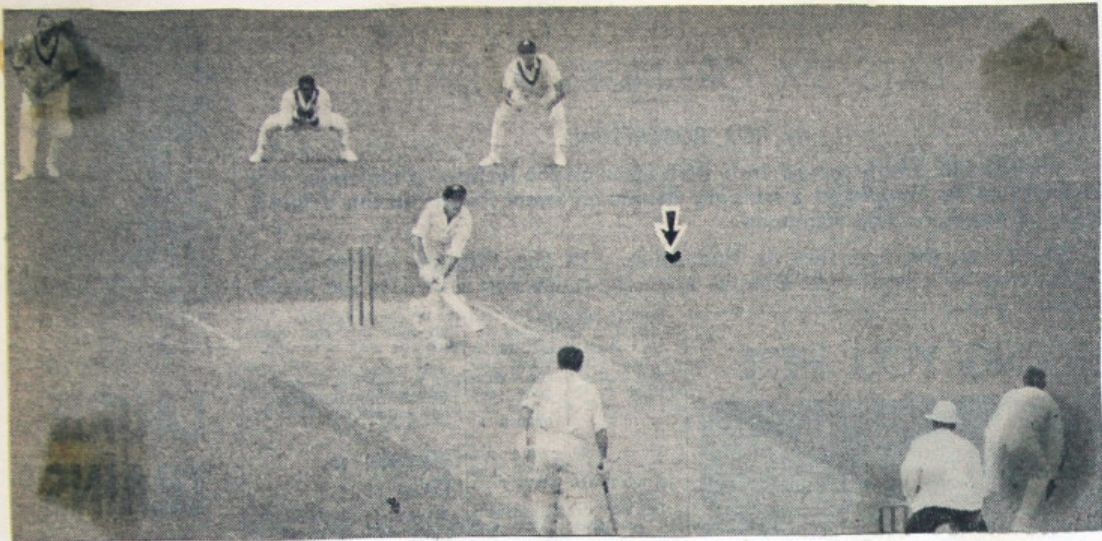

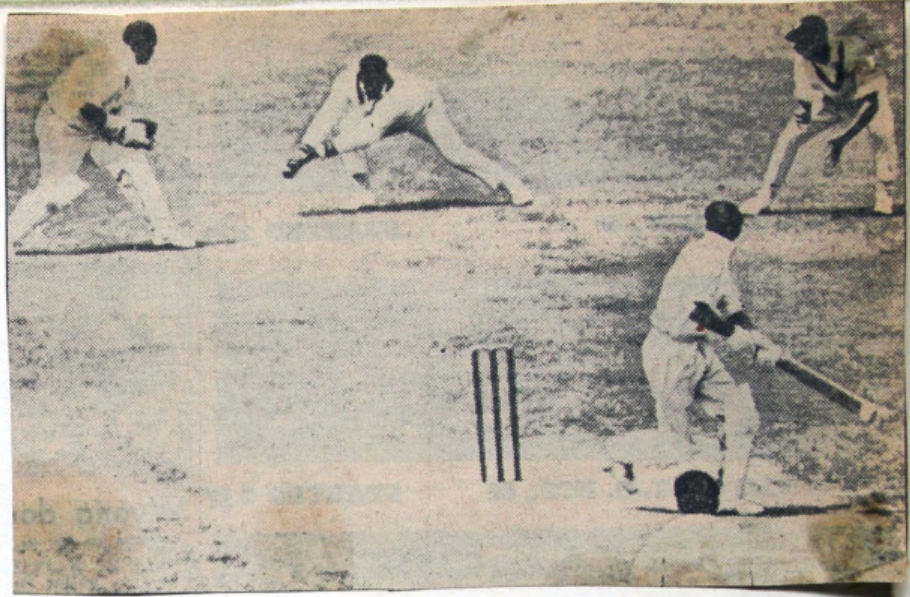


Lawry dropped by Butcher at 1st Slip.

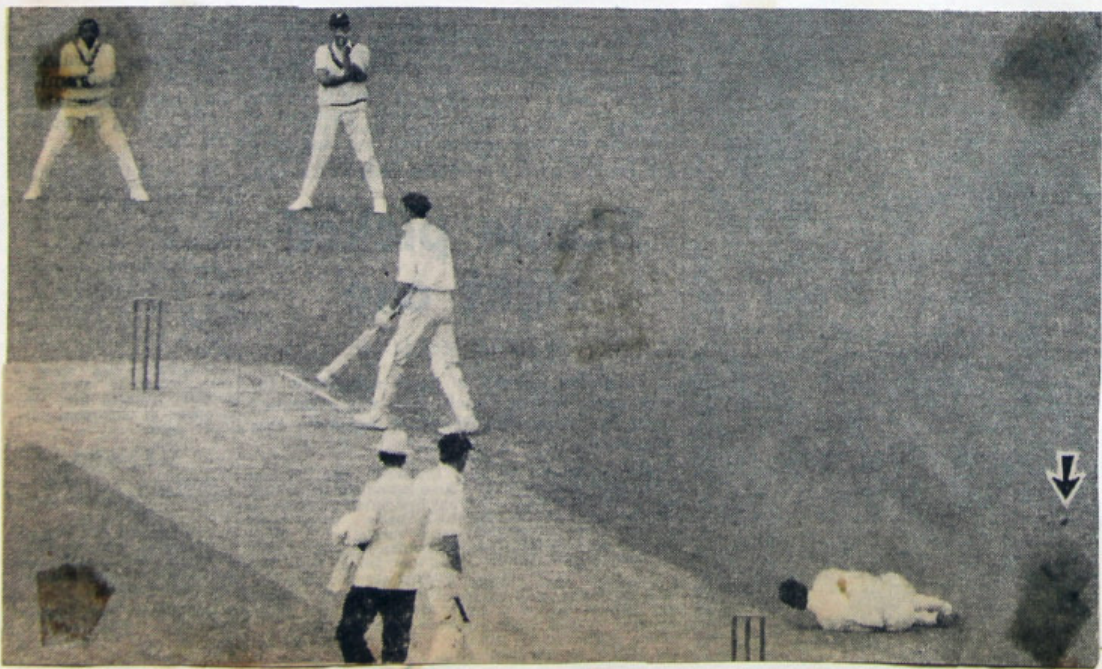




Above. Bill Lawry on 117 hits the ball straight back to Gary Sobers - who drops it ↓

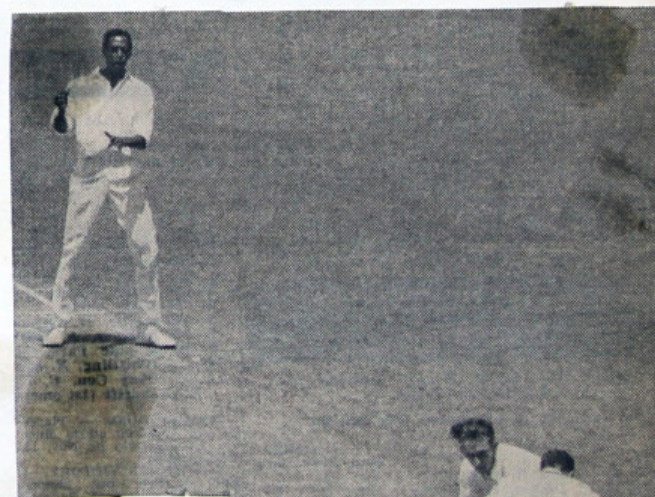
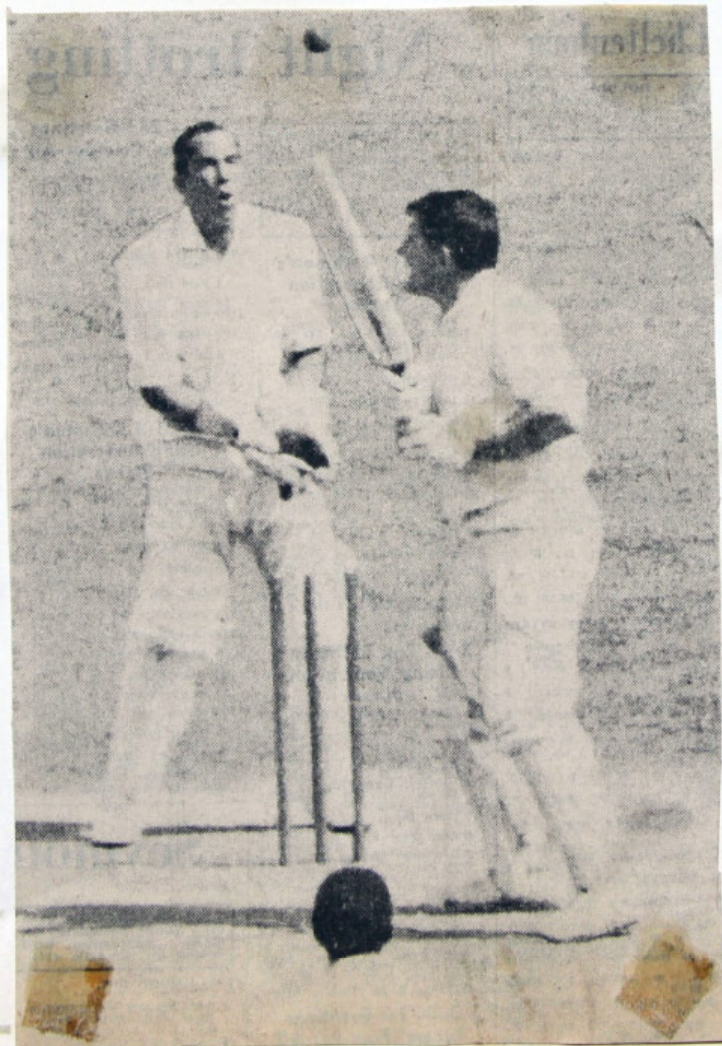

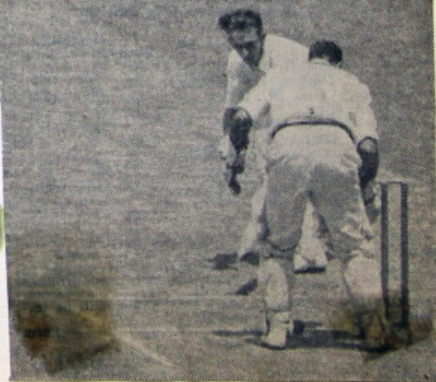

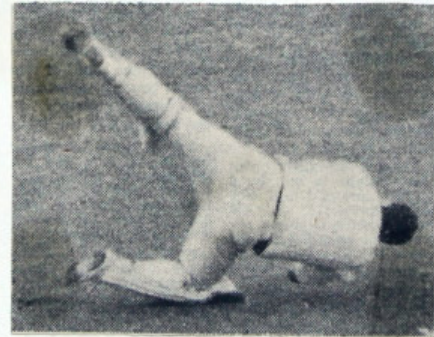
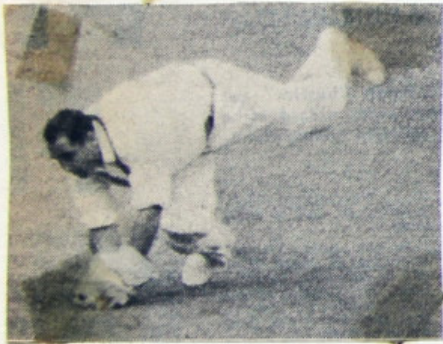


Bottom: Charlie Davis cannot hold this snick from Walters.

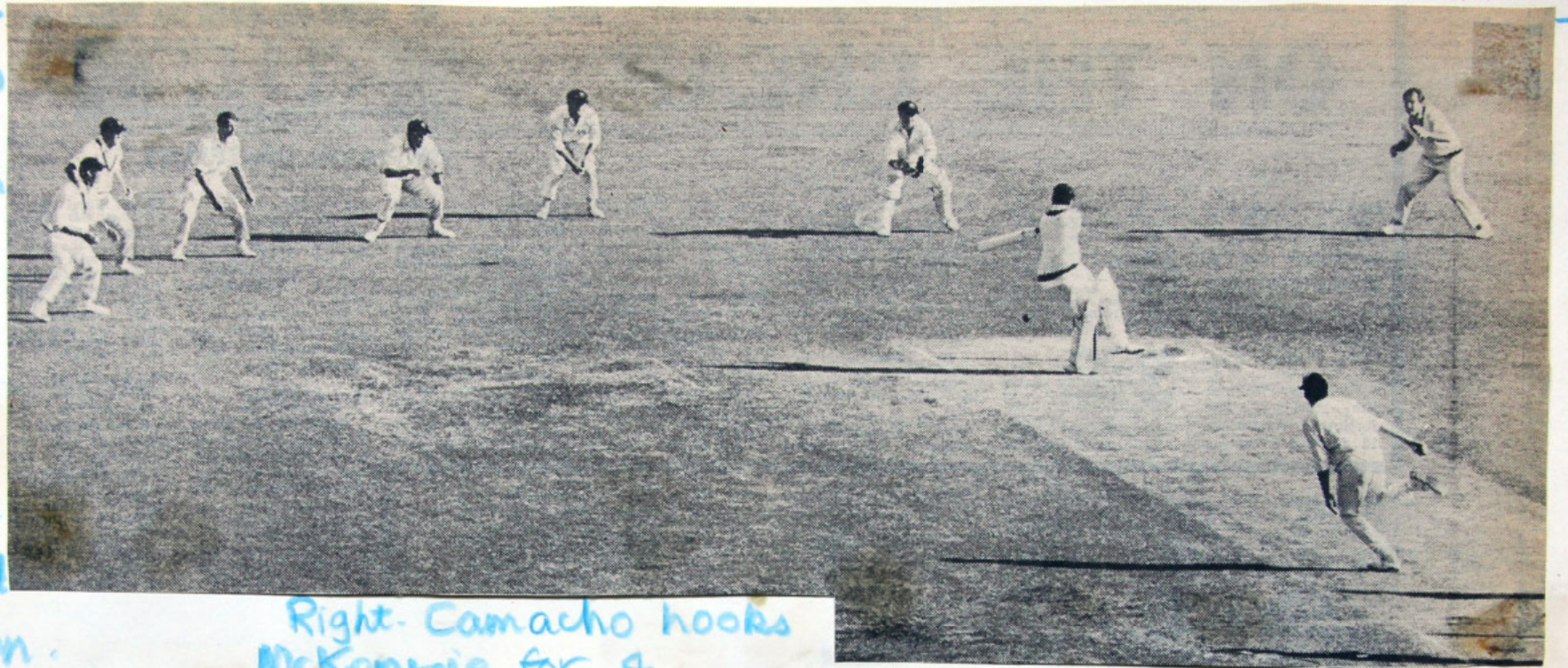


Below: Barry Jarman straight drives a ball from Gary Sobers, Left: Walters is given not out after an LBW appeal from Gibbs

Below: Jackie Hendricks dives to stop 1 ball wide of the stumps. He finally was rewarded by catching Ian Redpath.

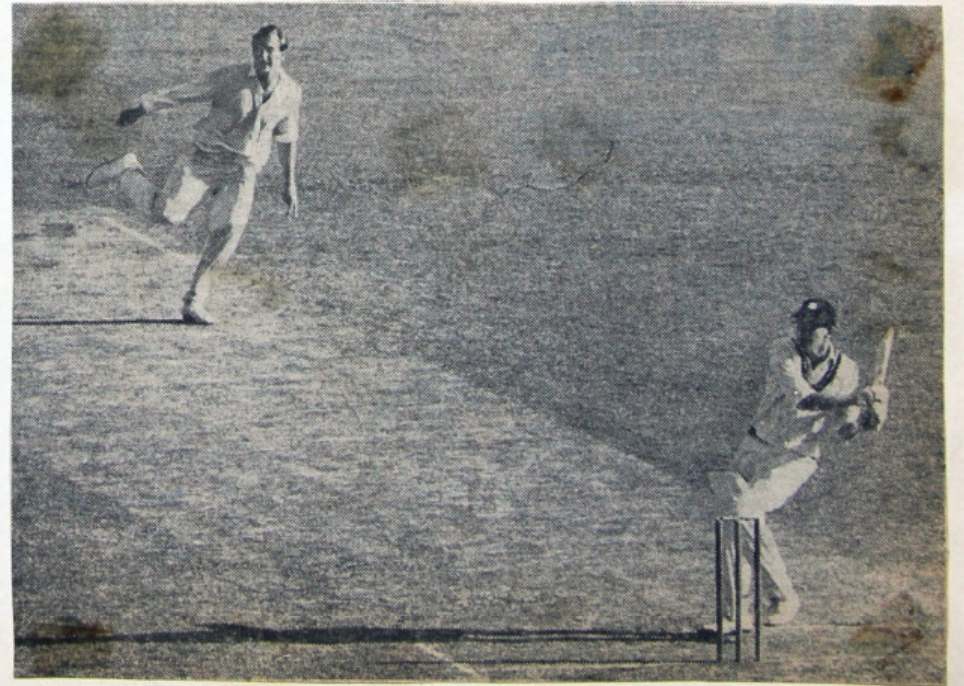
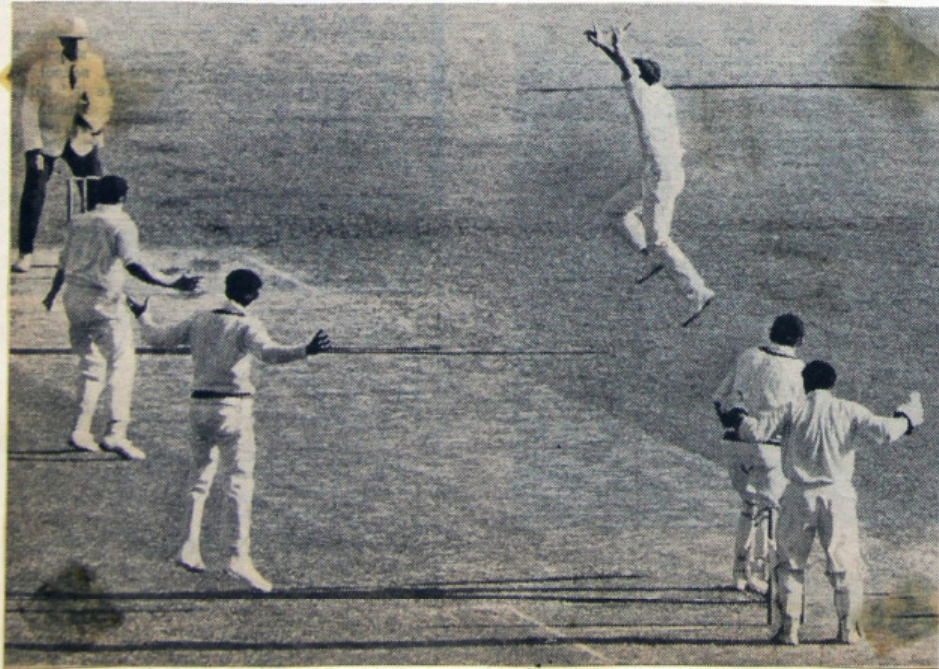


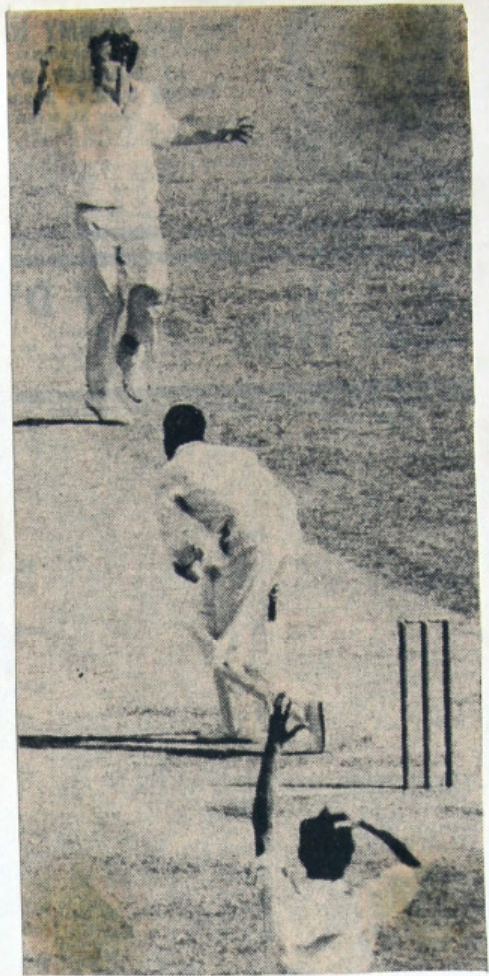

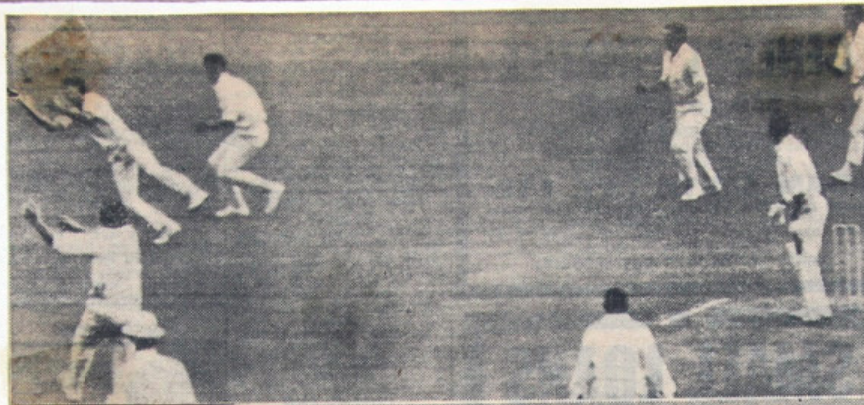

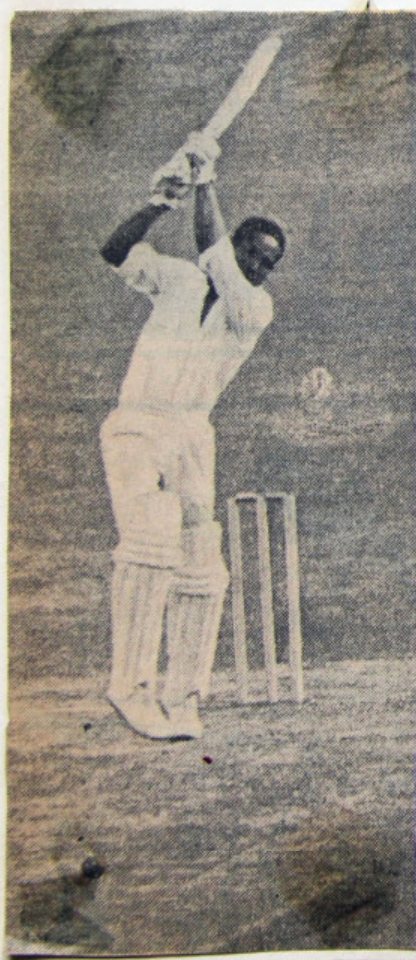

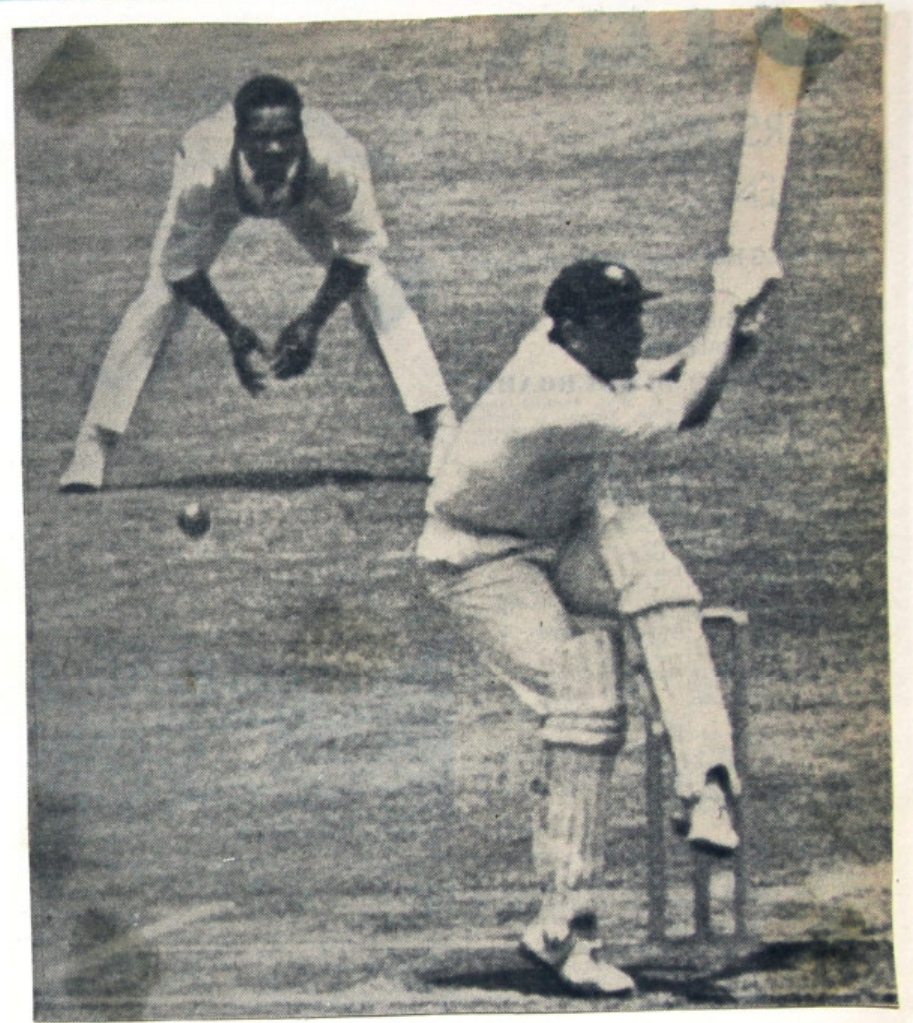
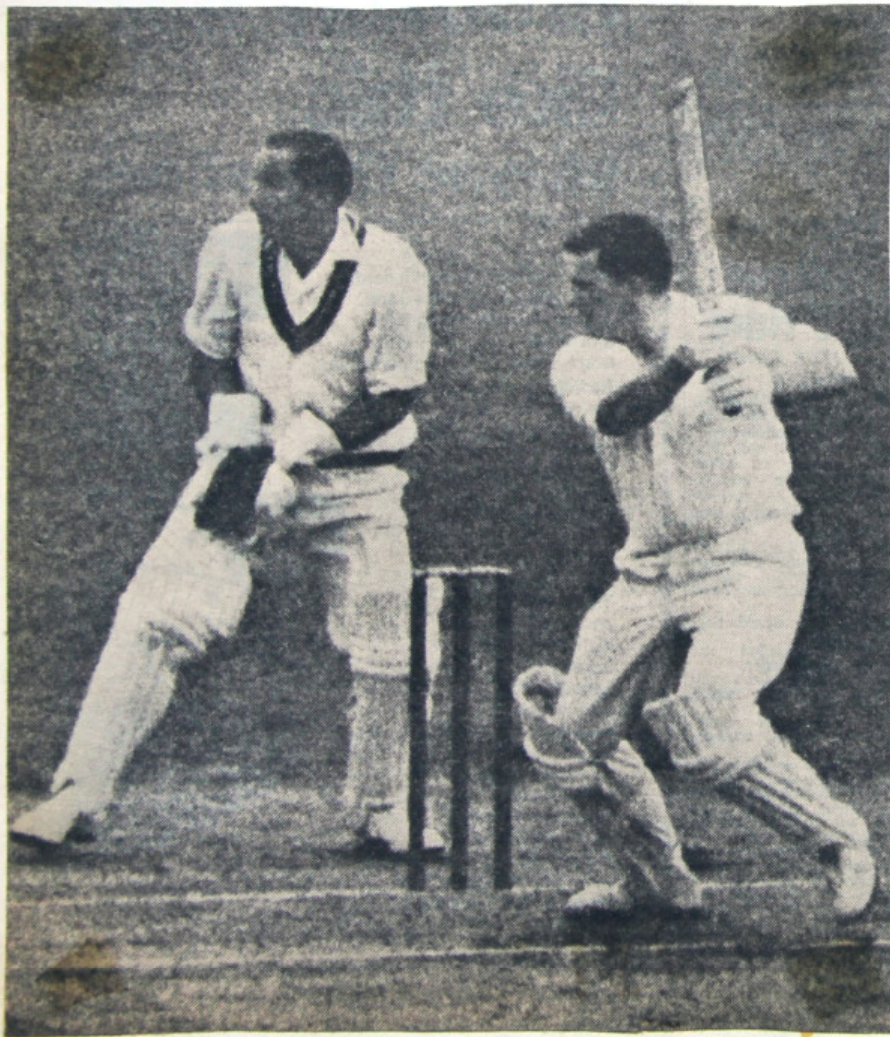

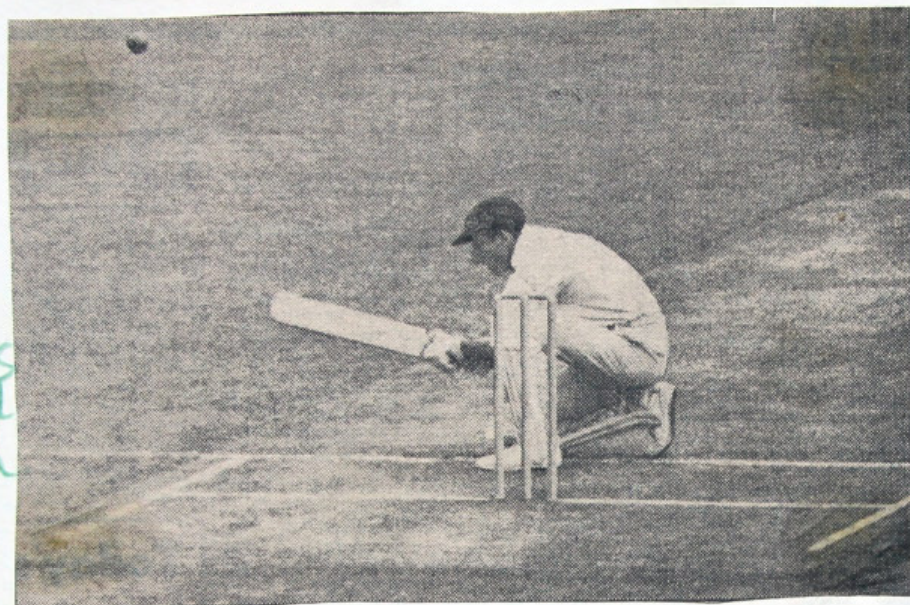

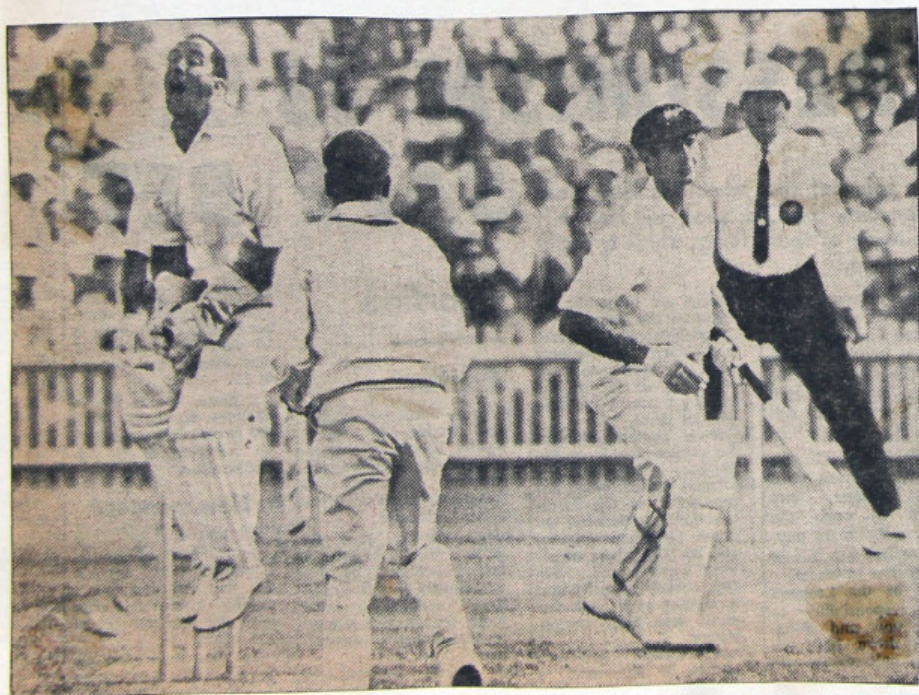

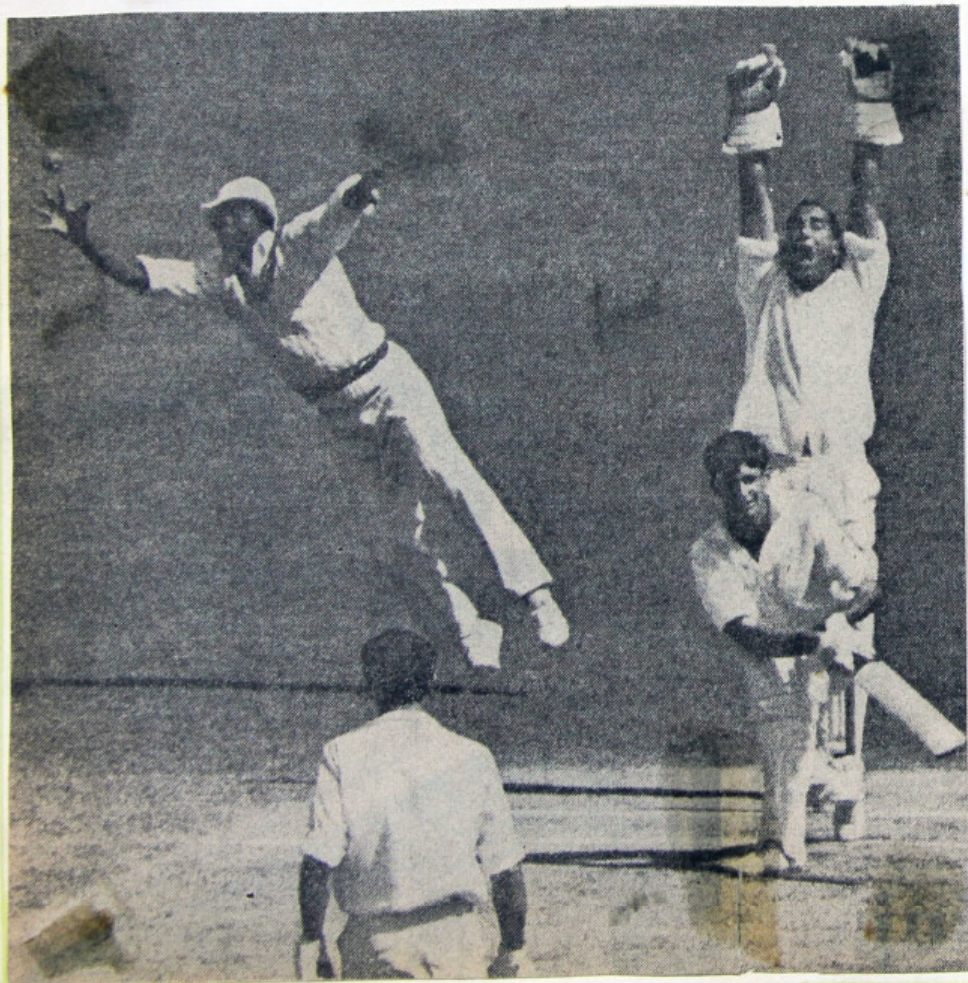

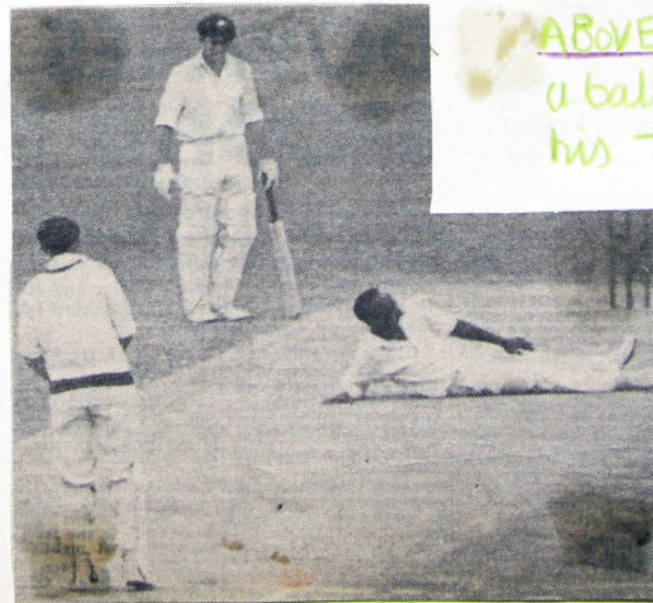

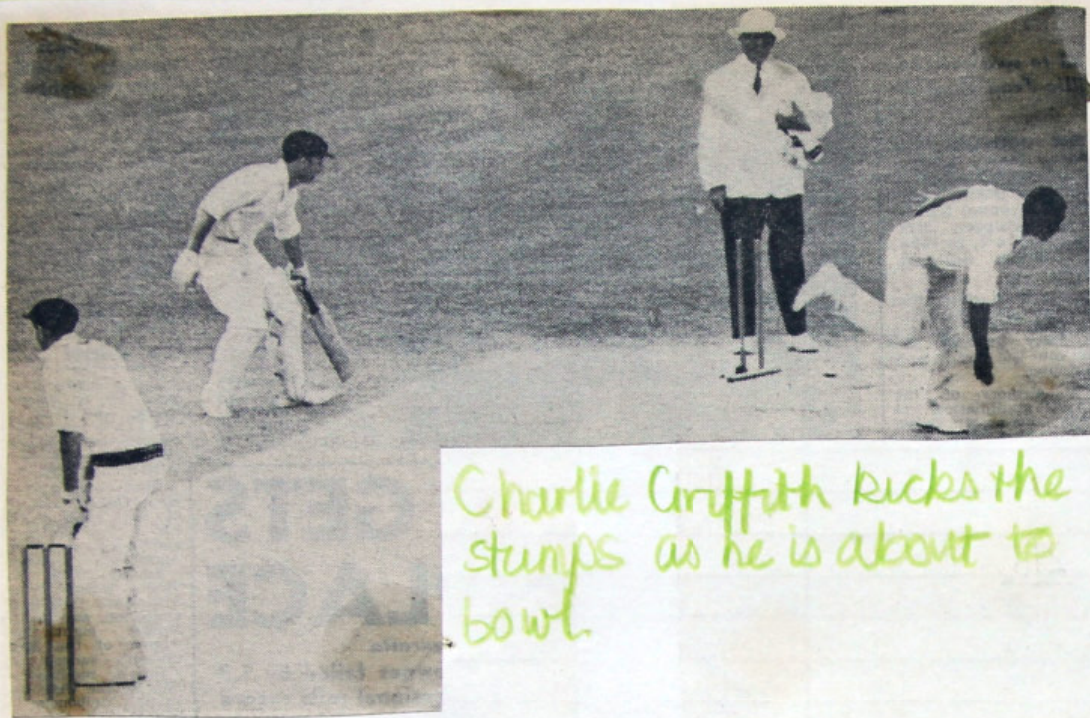

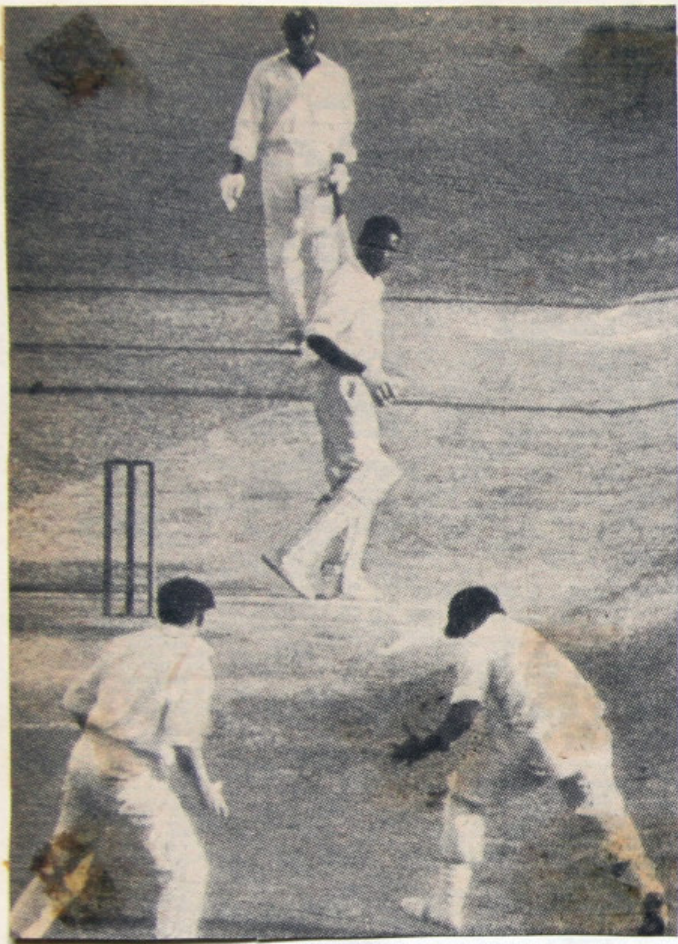

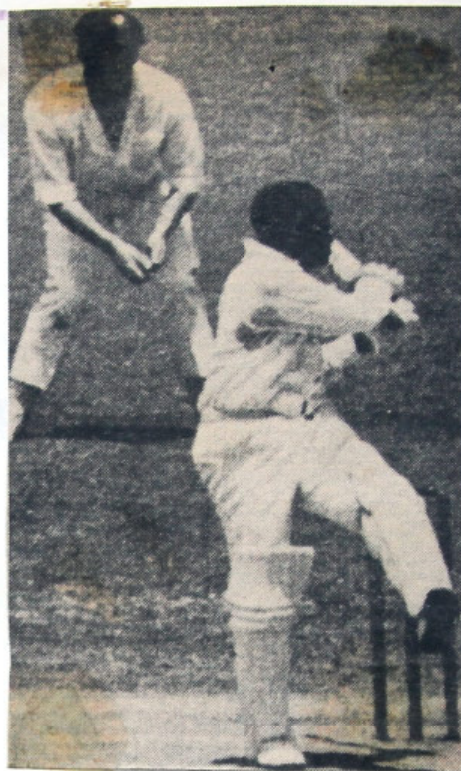
