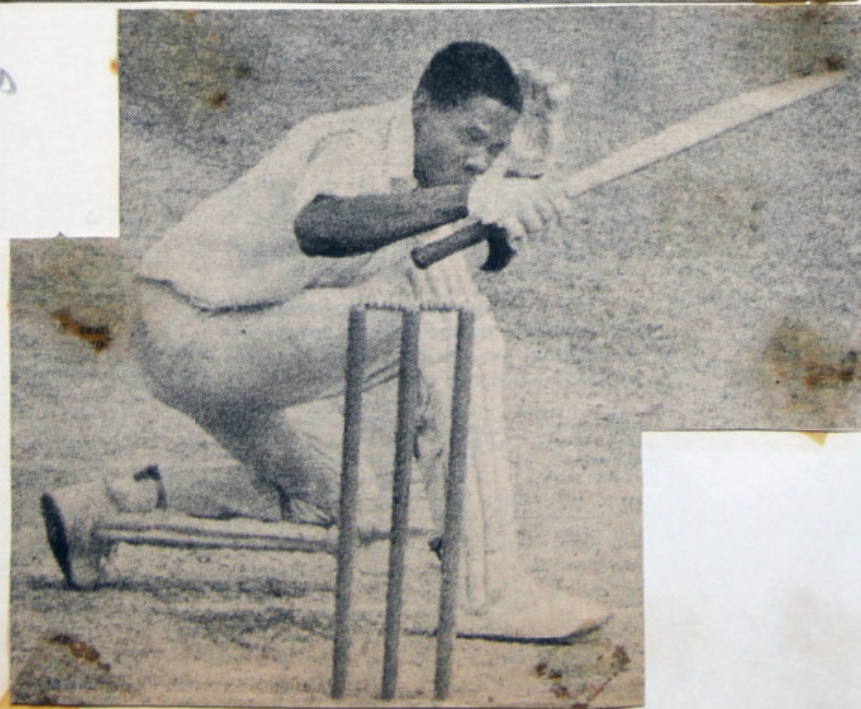

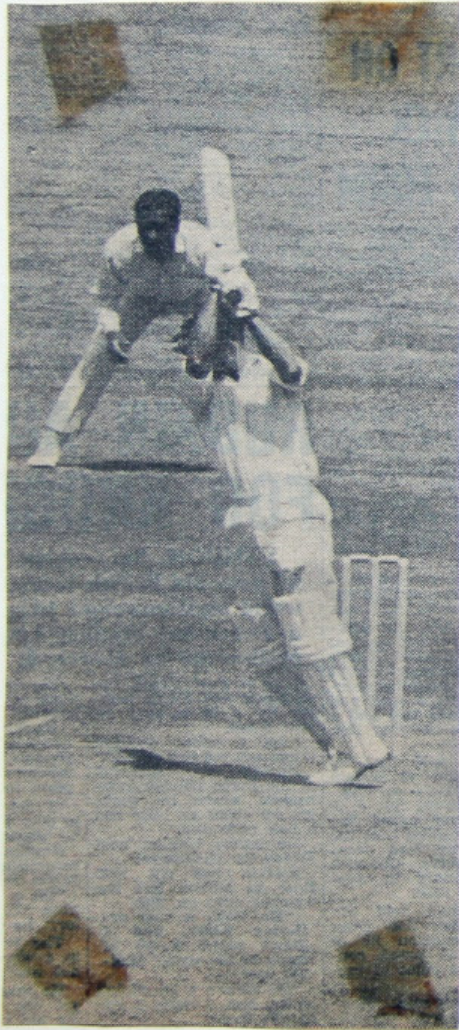

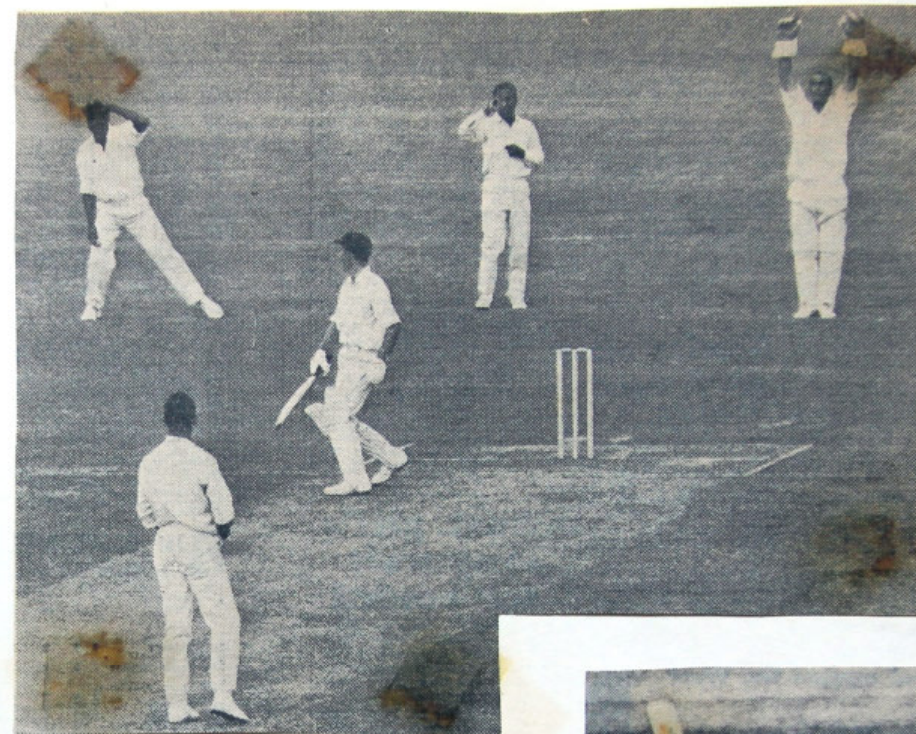

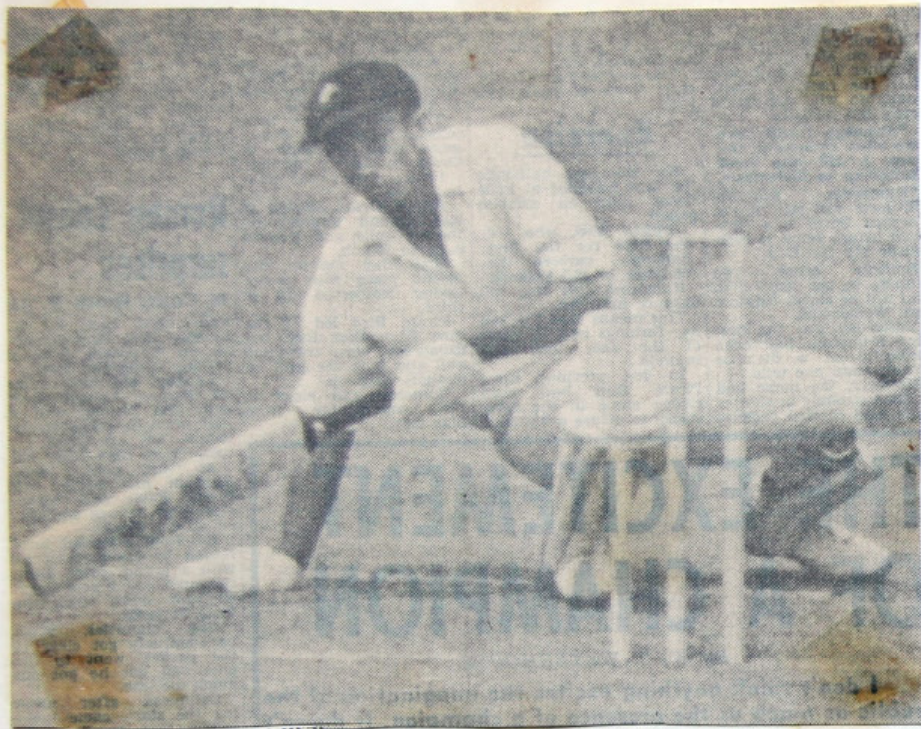

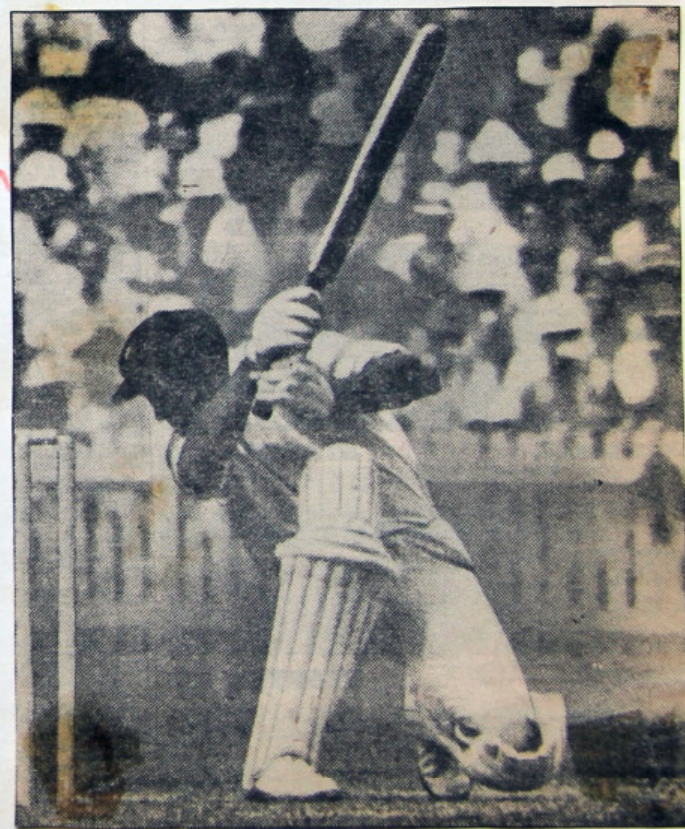

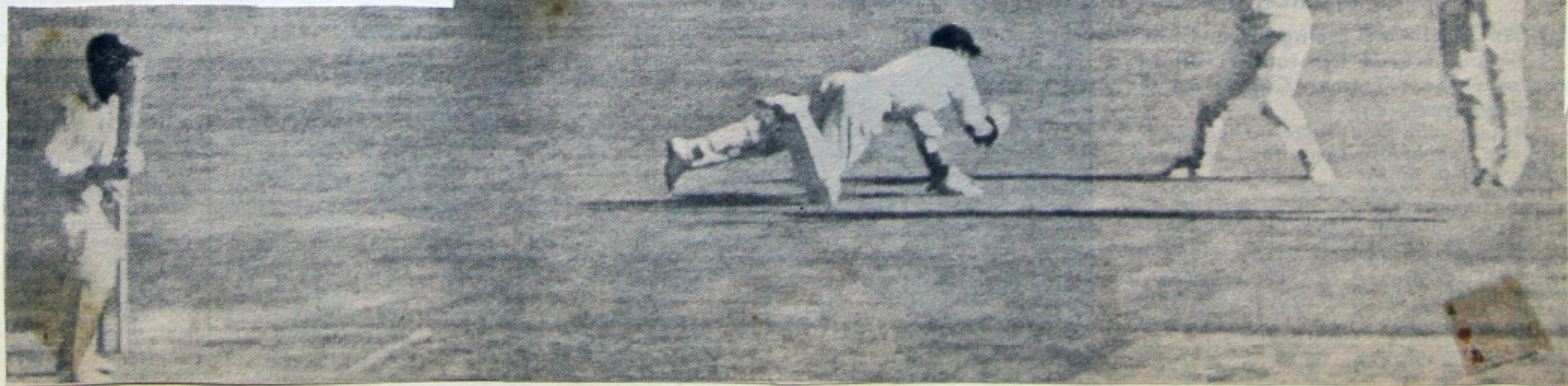


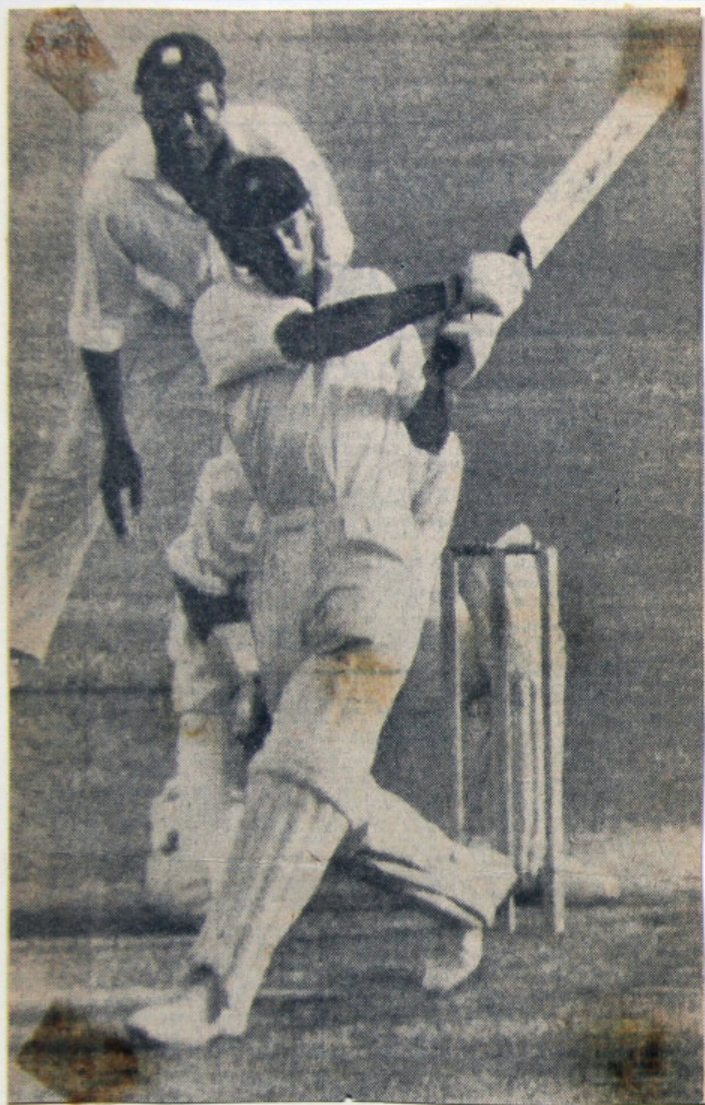
Doug Walters is bowled by Lance Gibbs for 242. The highest individual score against the West Indies, by an Australian. McKenzie is the other batsman.



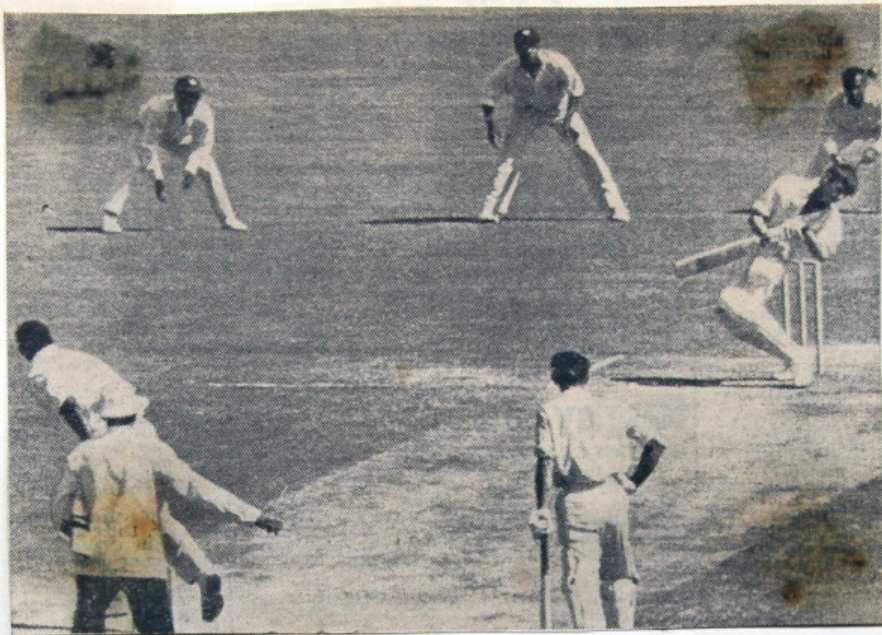

RIGHT: Brian Taber takes a diving catch to dismiss Roy Fredericks for 39.

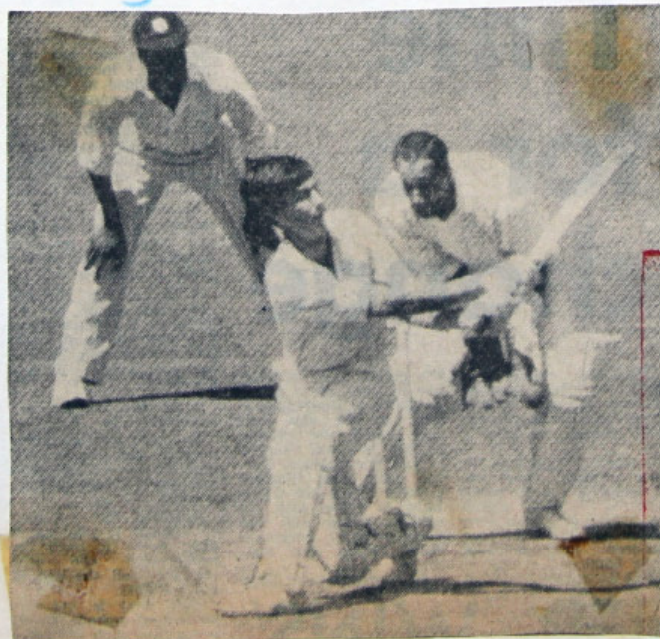

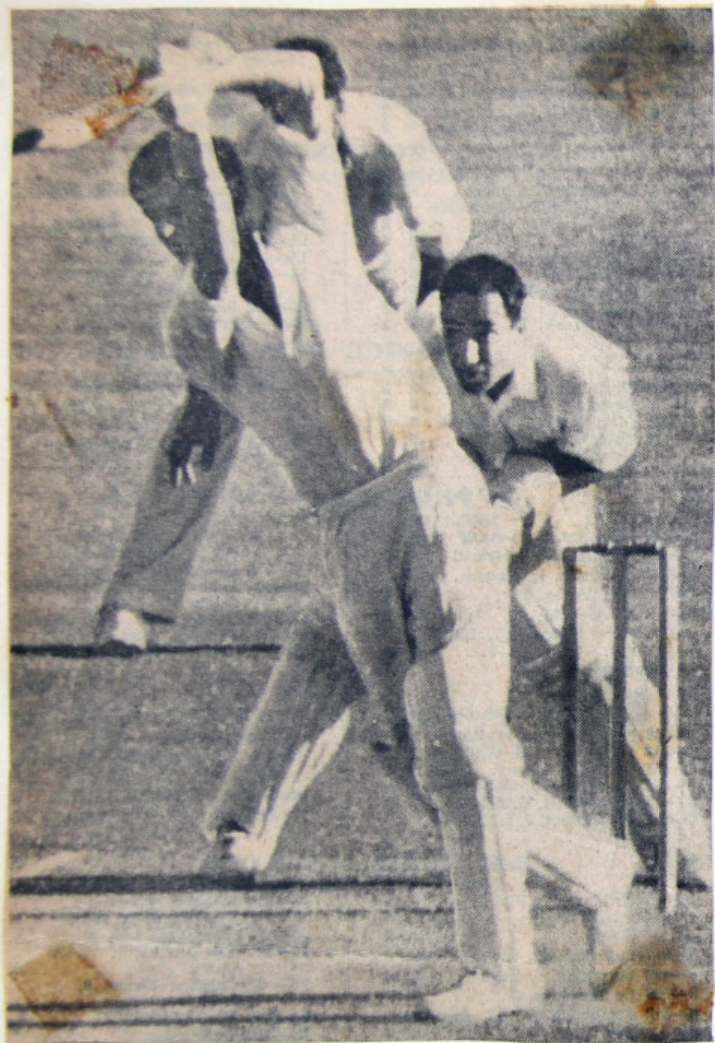

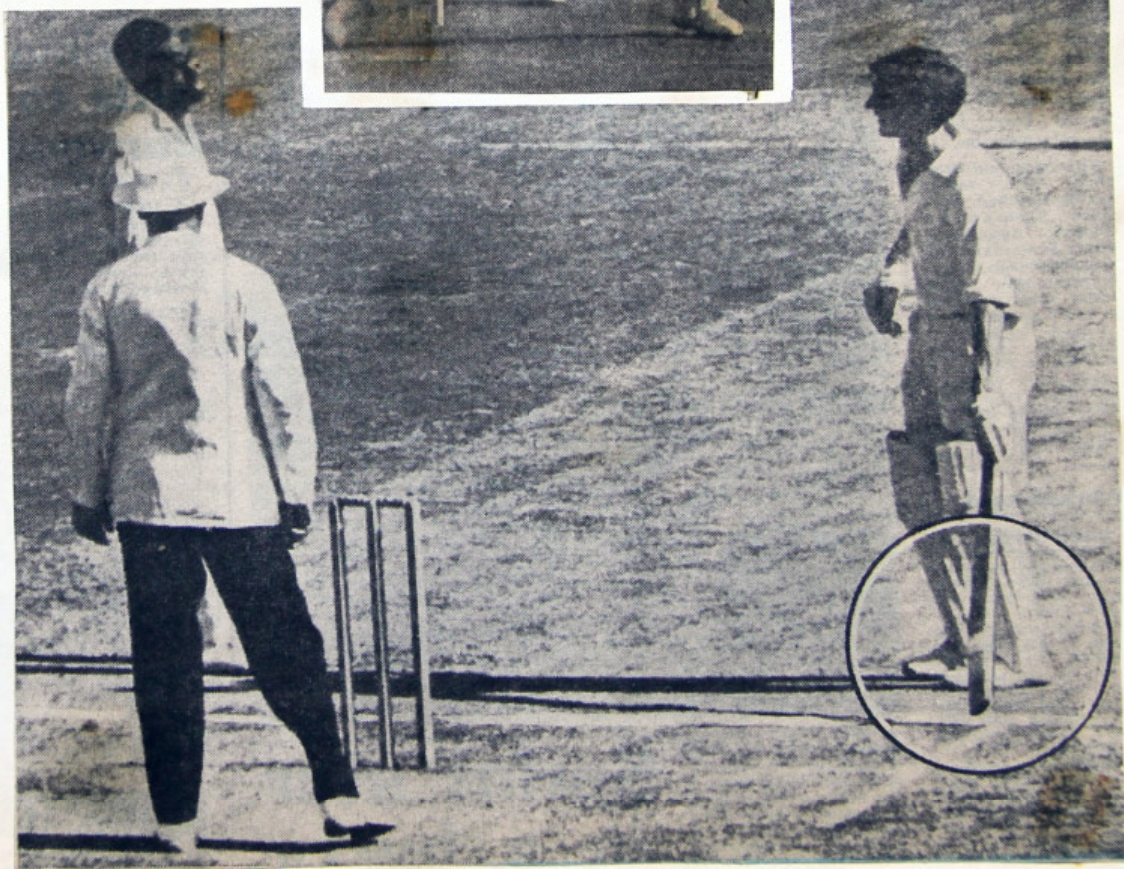
