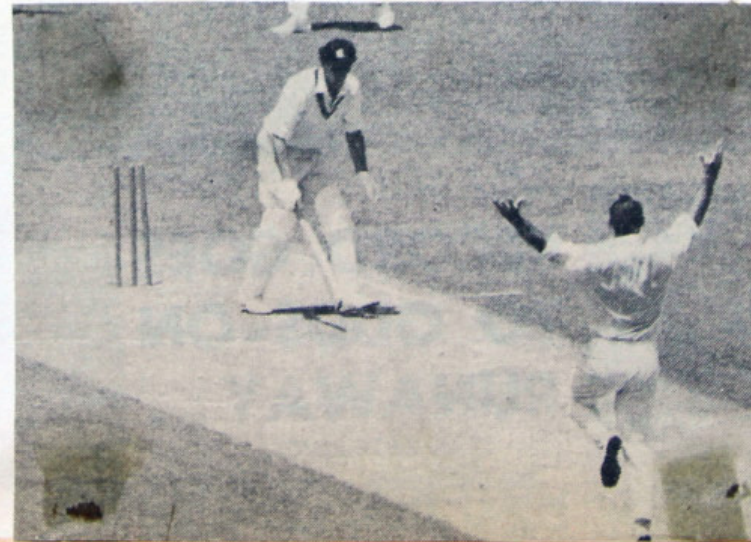

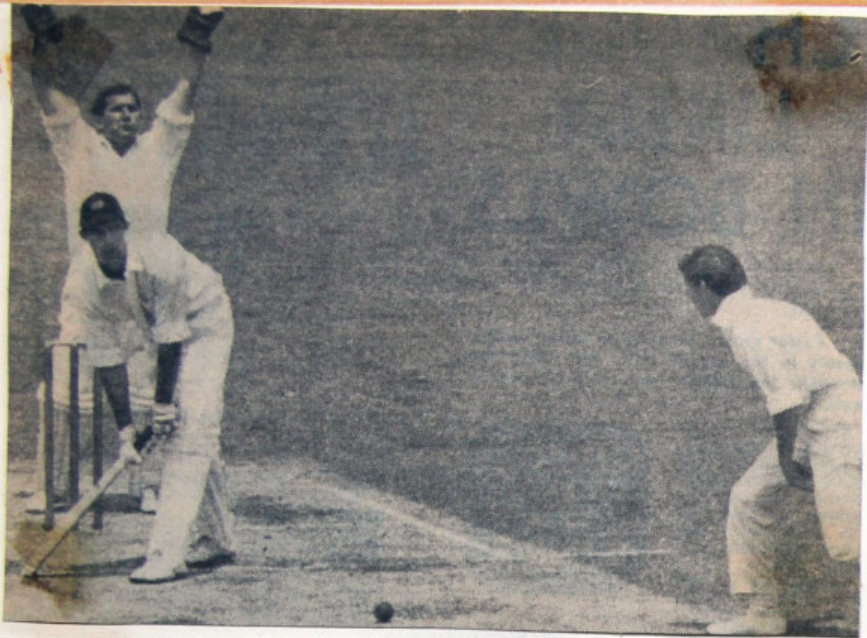

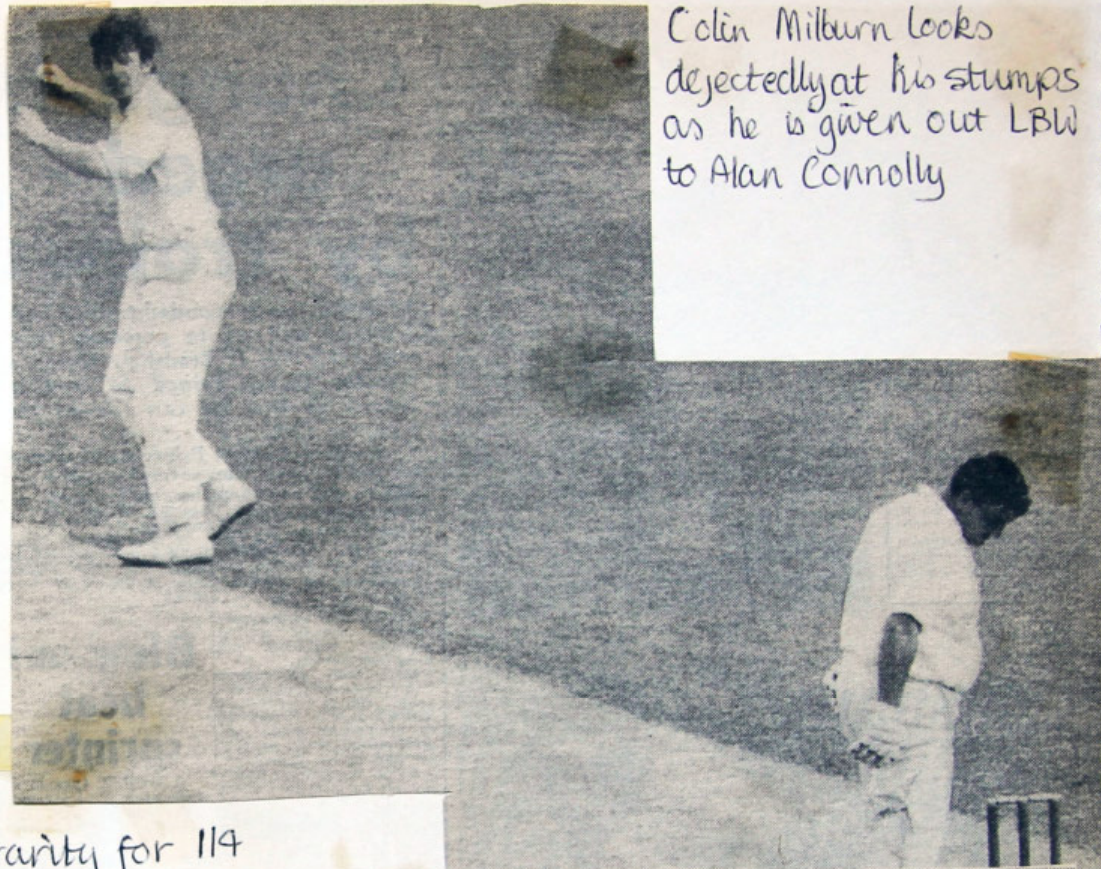




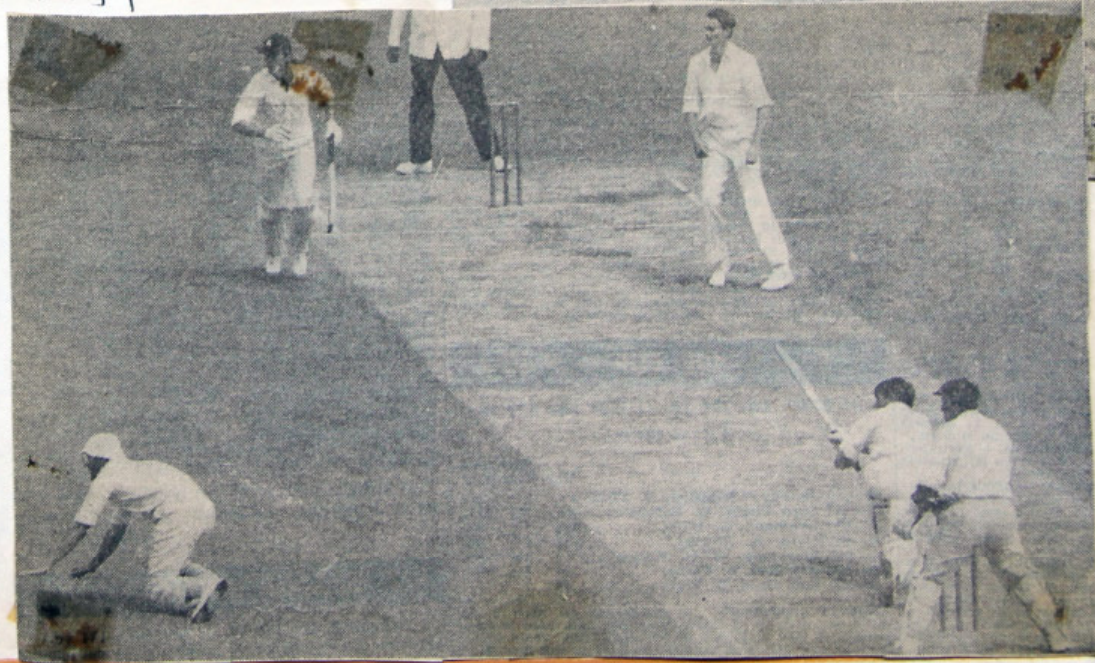

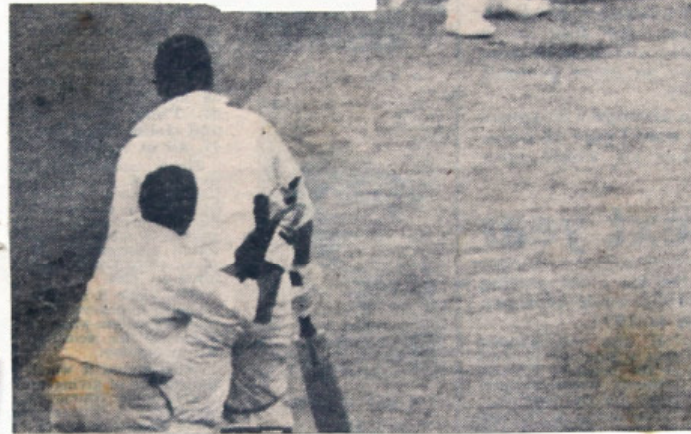

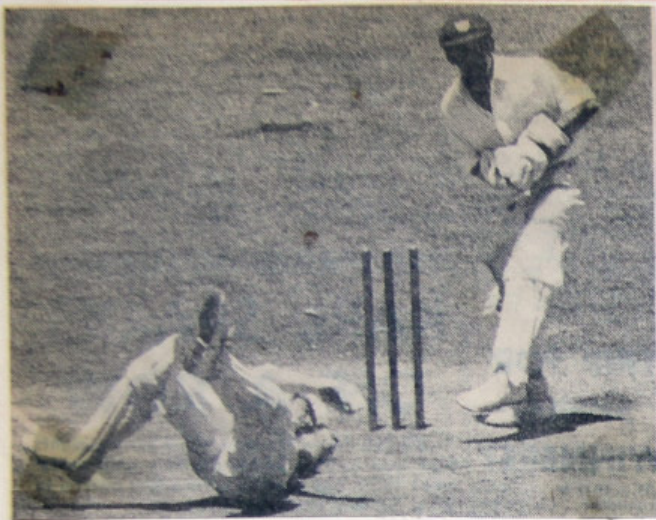

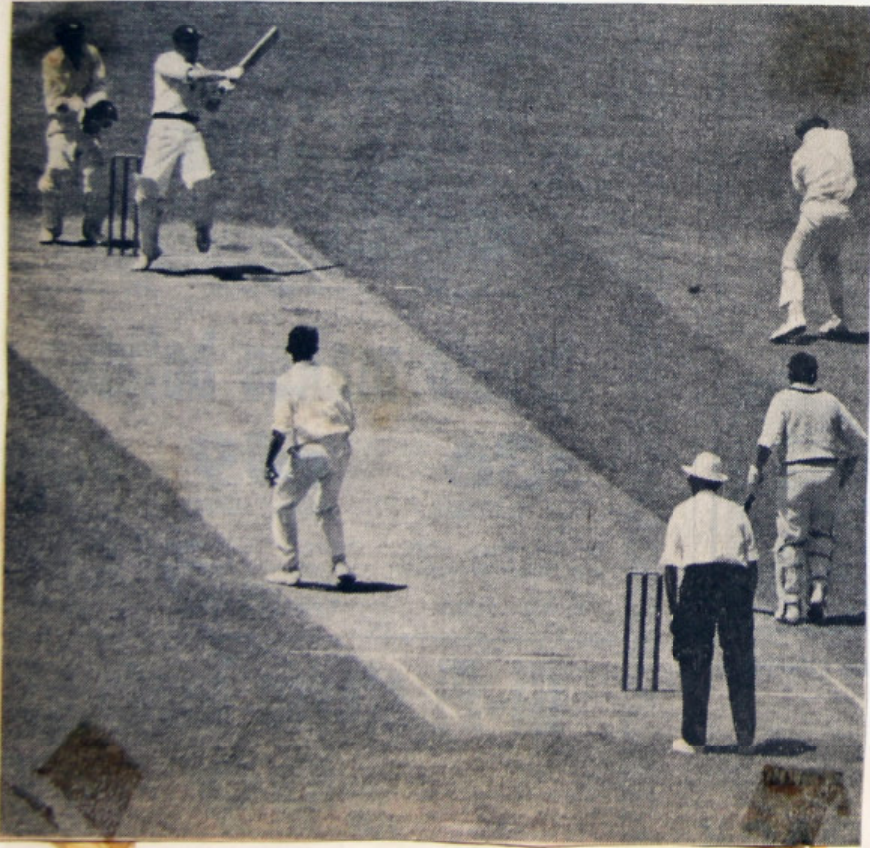

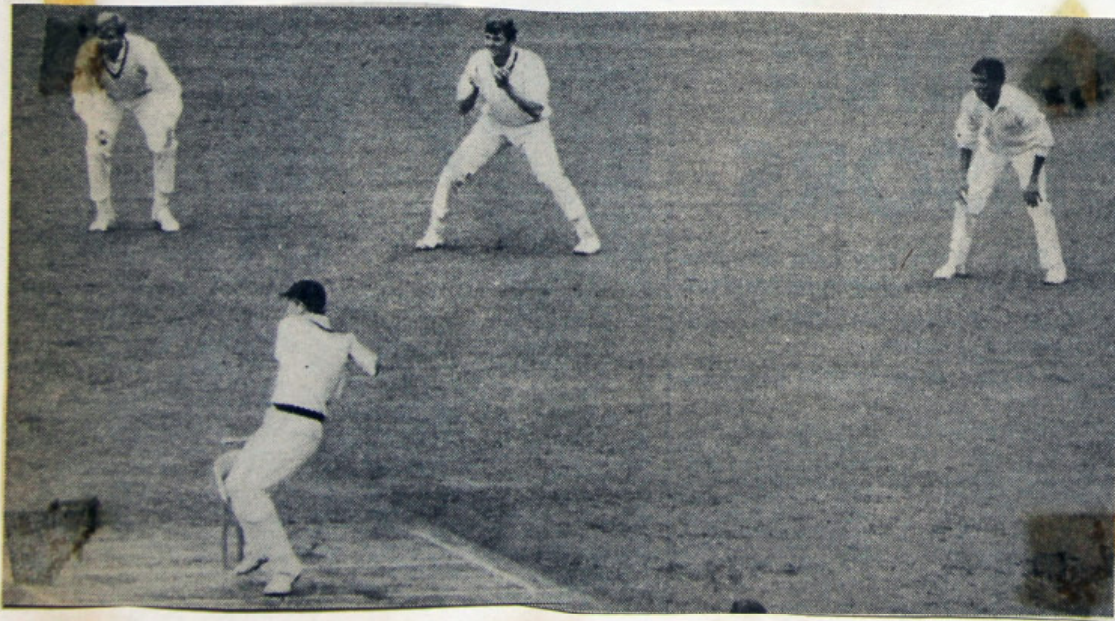

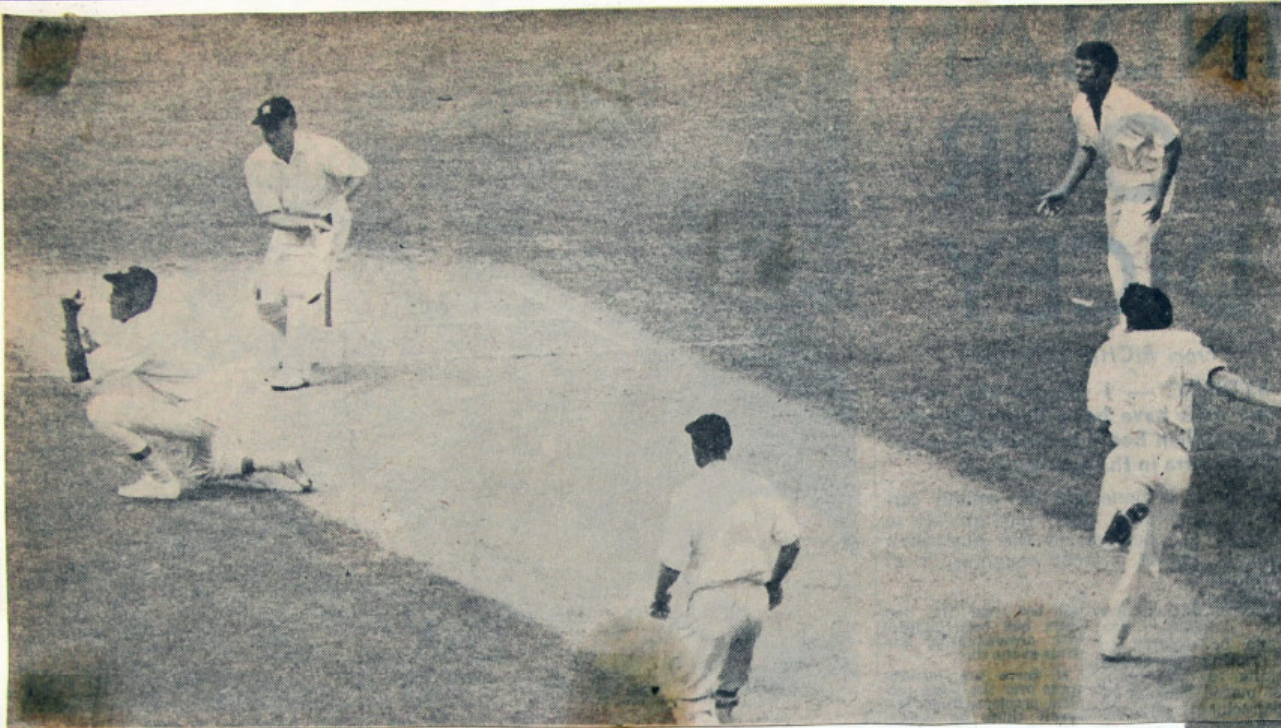

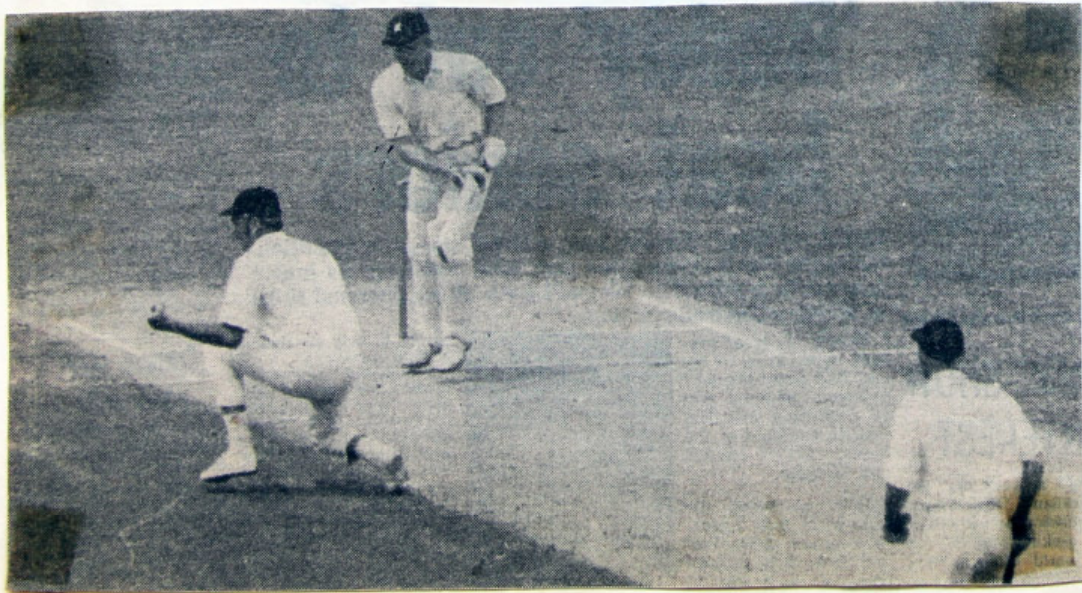

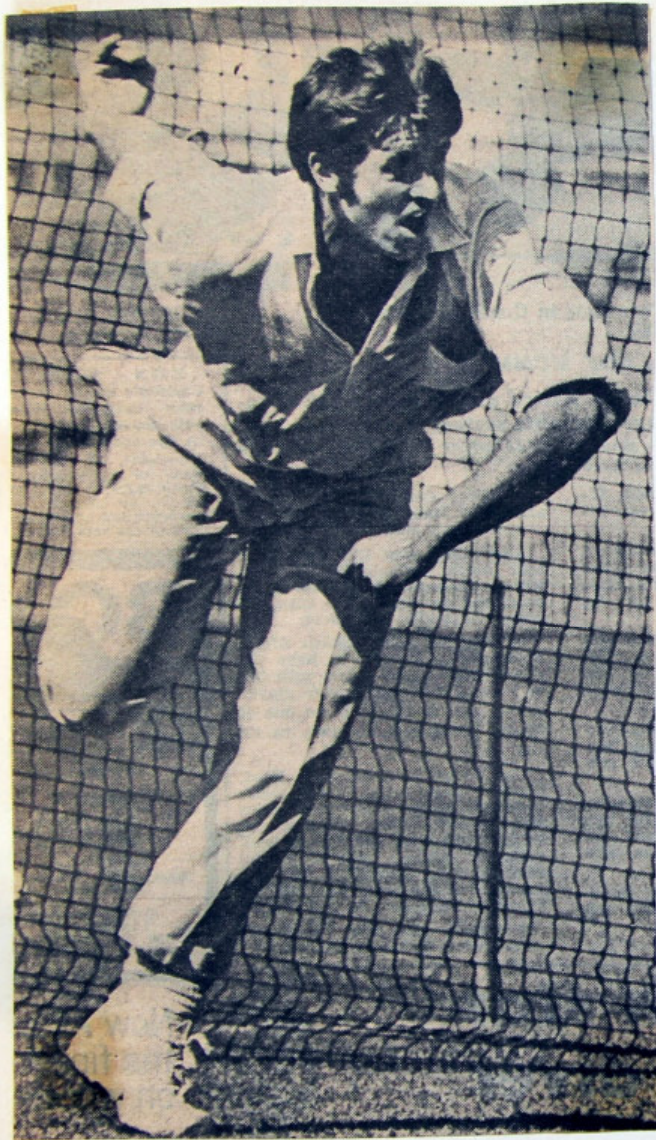

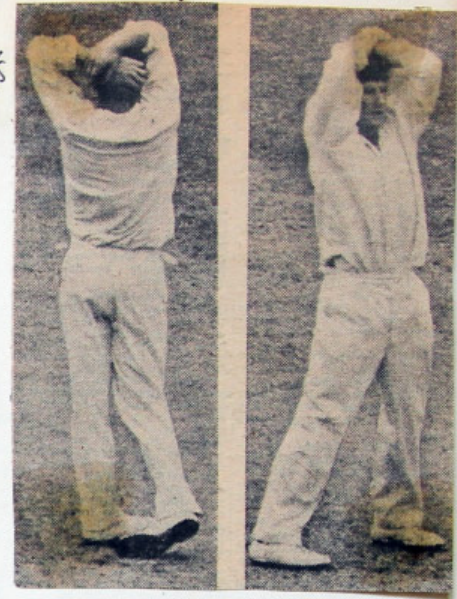

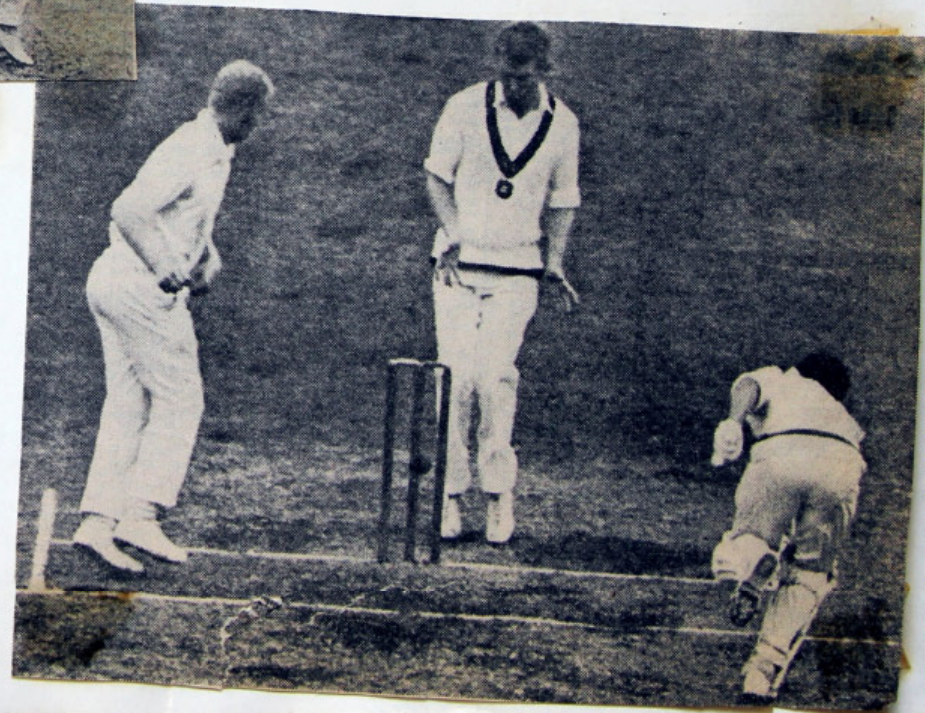

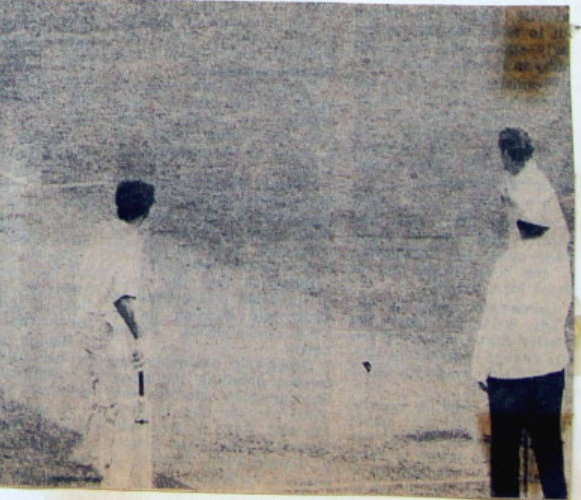
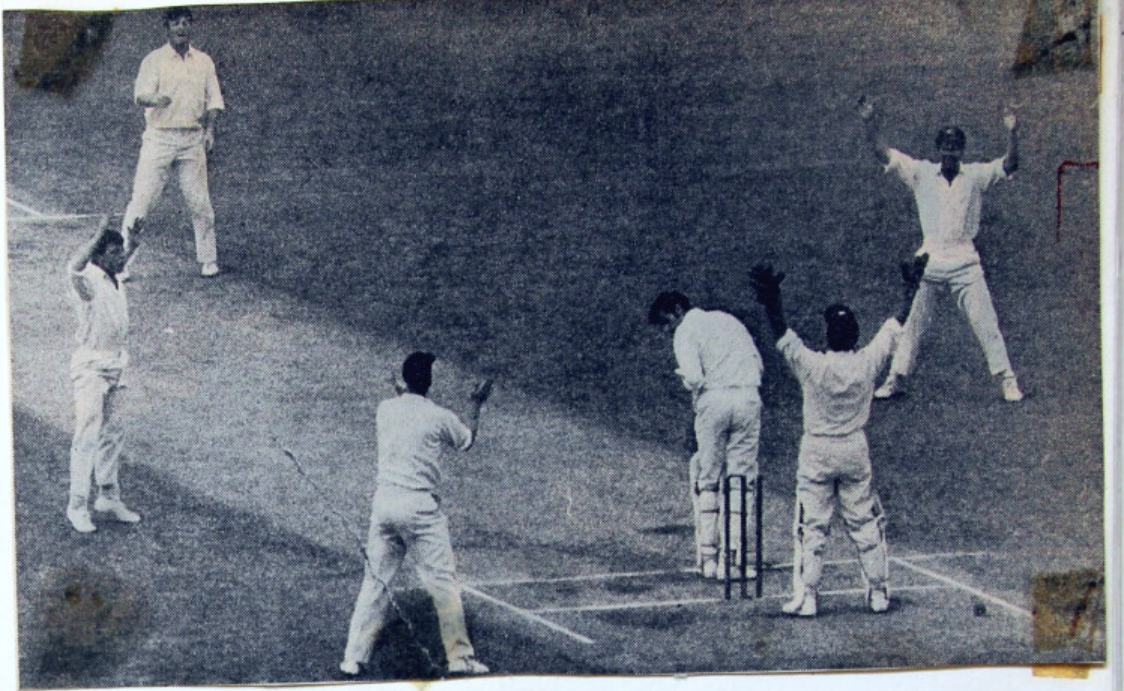


Rod Marsh supports Terry MacGill's appeal against Peter Bedford for an LBW decision, but Bedford was given not out.

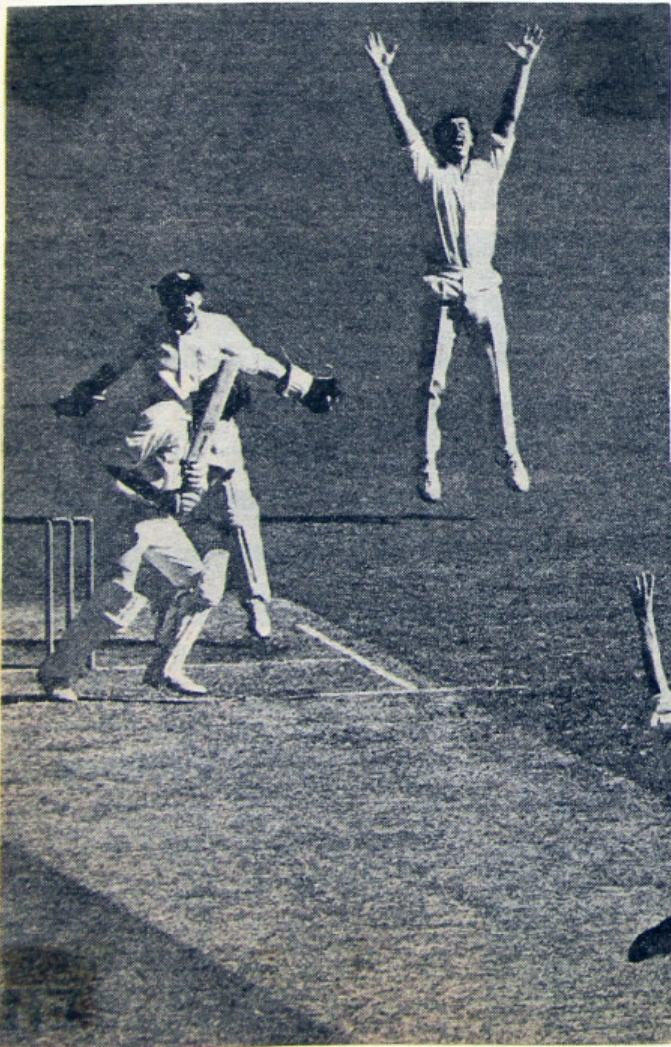
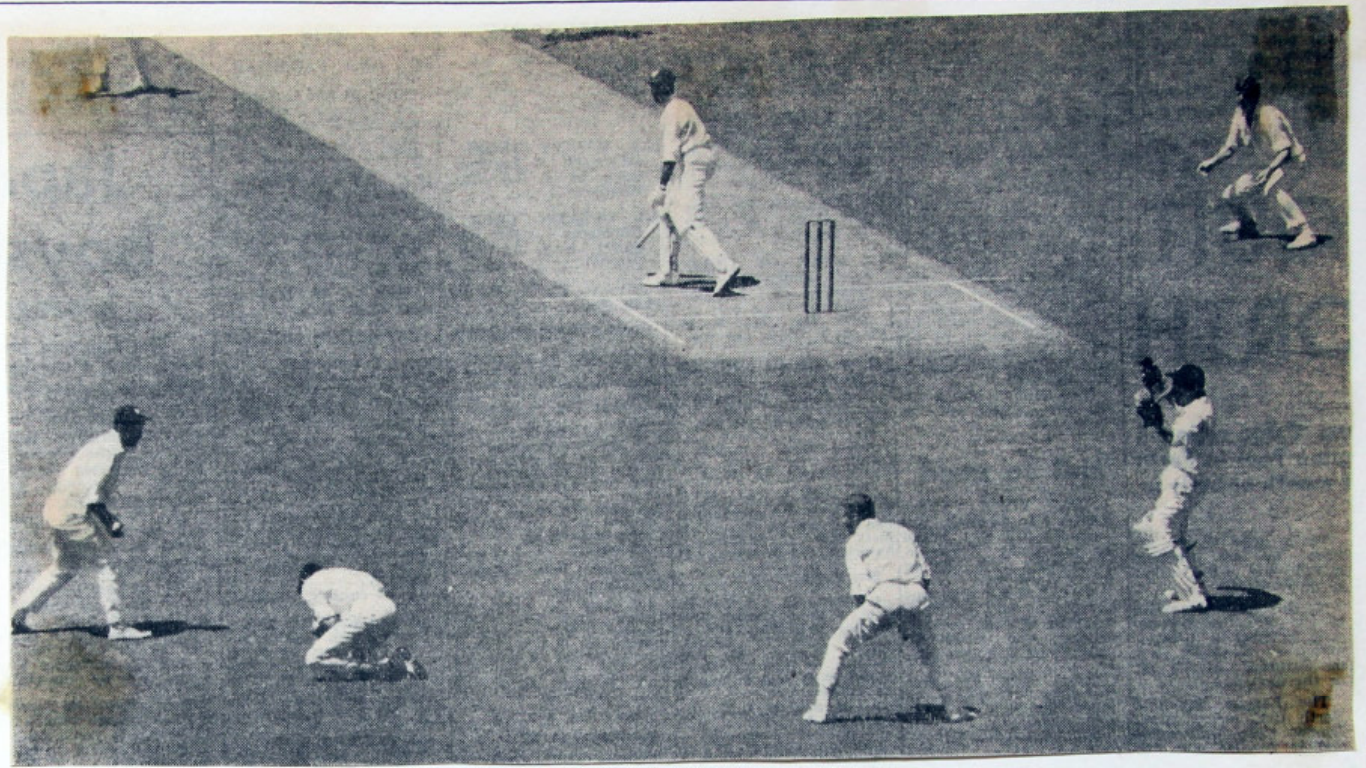

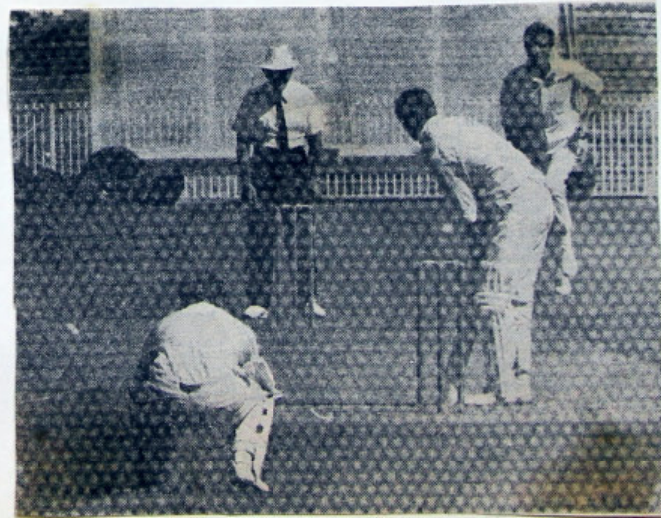

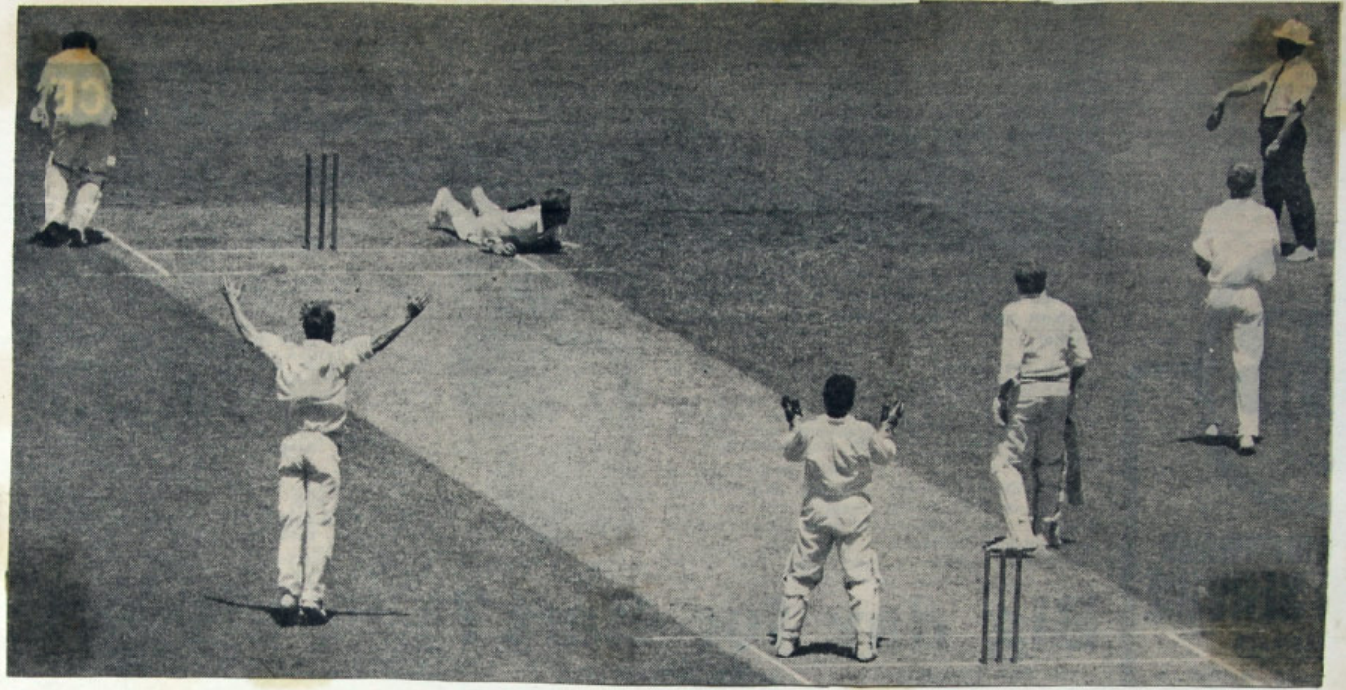

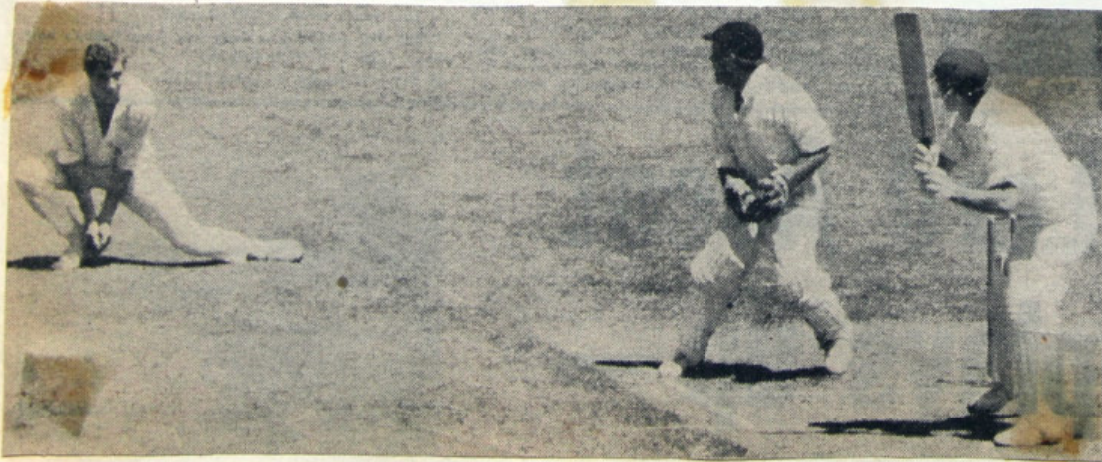

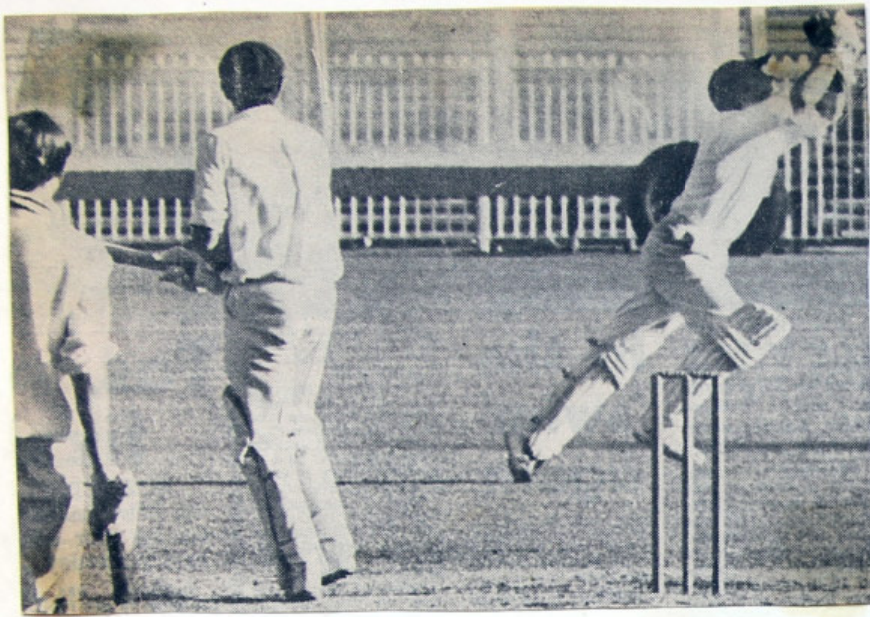

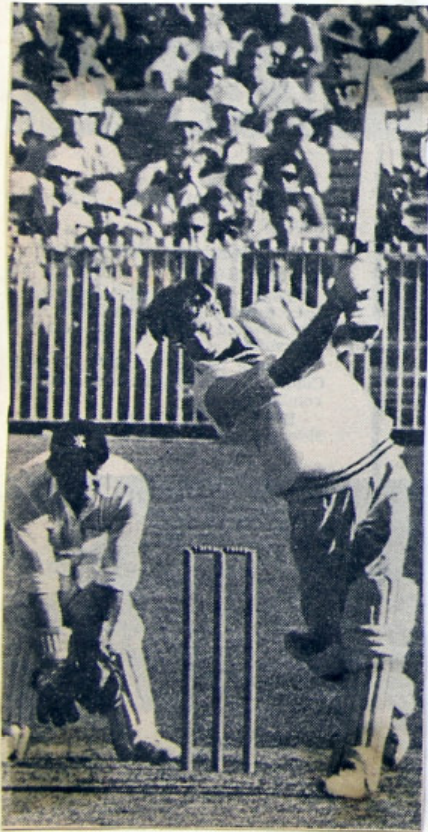
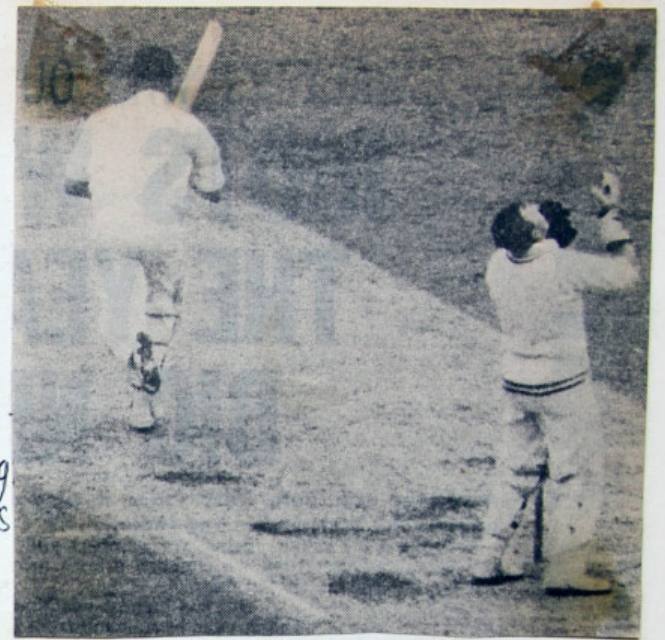

Robert Rowan cuts the ball and starts off for the winning run... Mike Henricks throws back his head and O'Keefe turns away.



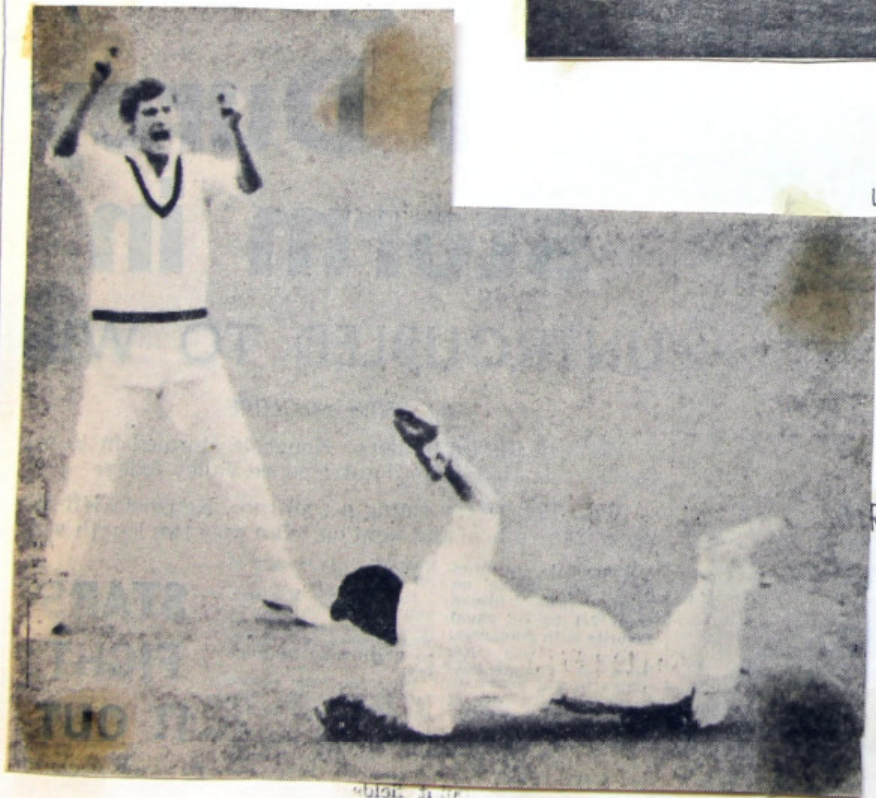
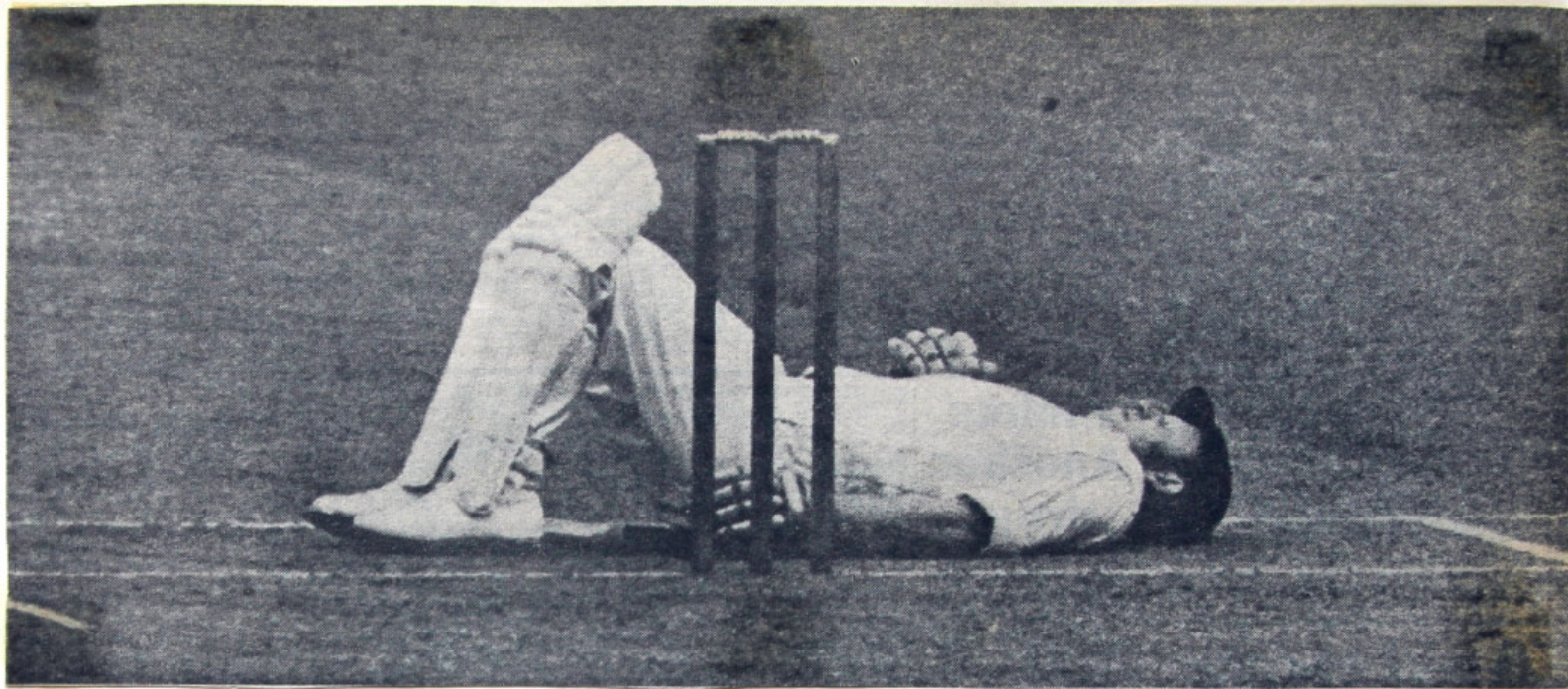


Keeping wickets can be hard on the emotions . . .

New South Wales 'keeper Mick Hendricks knows all about it after the cliff-hanger finish to the Shield match at the MCG yesterday.

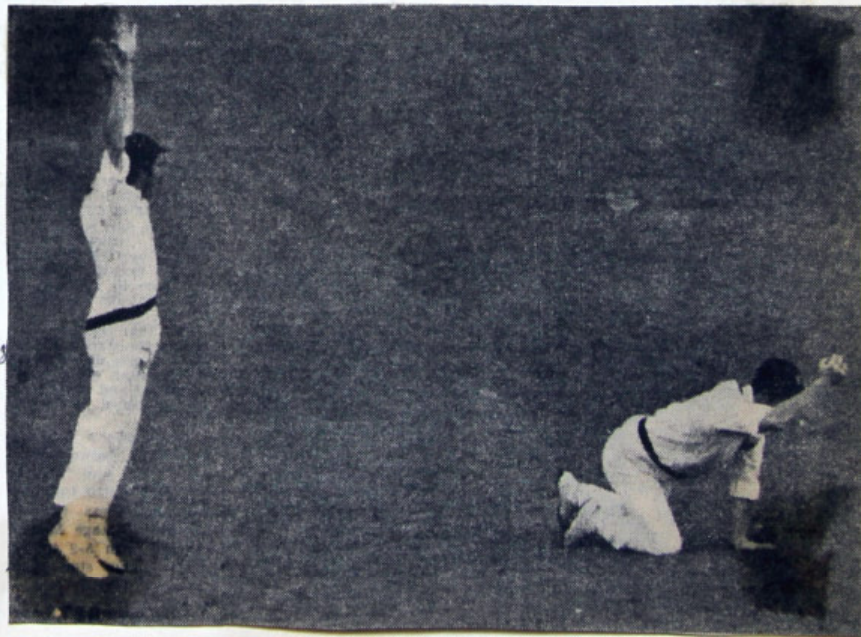
- 1—HUNGRY HENDRICKS** is poised to grab the ball — Victorian batsman Graeme Watson has swished and missed and he's out of his crease.

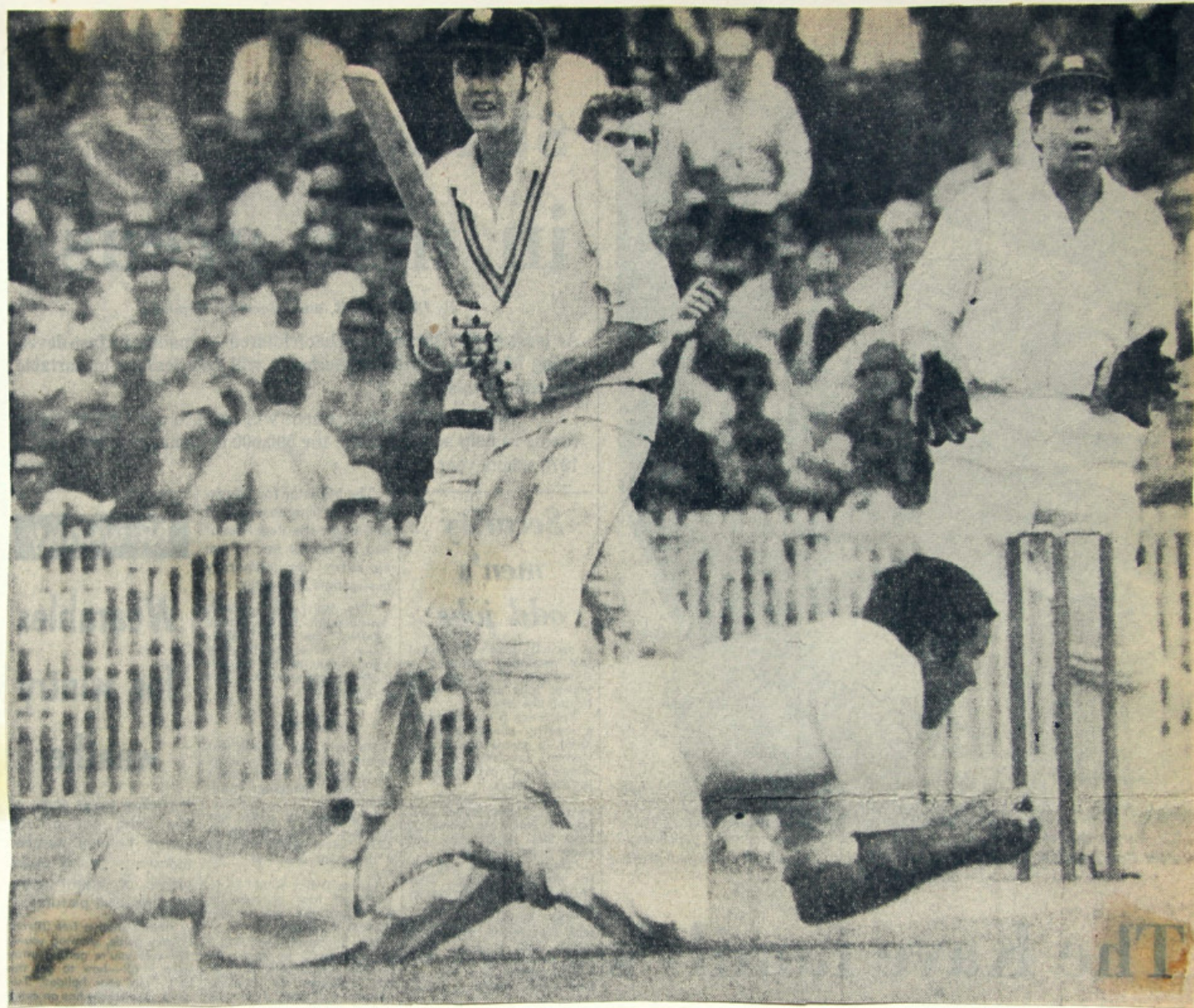

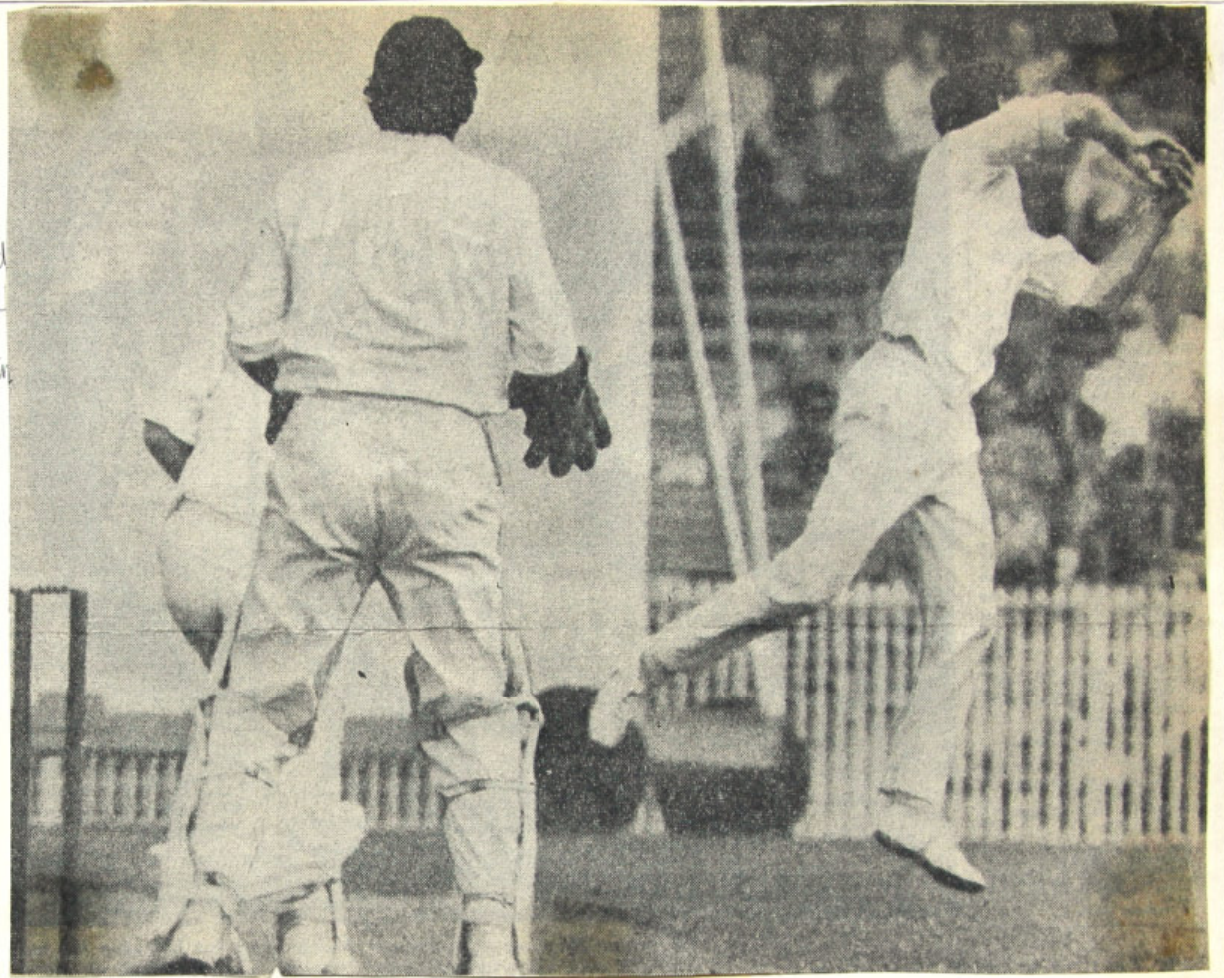
