

An introduction to the Spanish Civil War of 1936-39, an intense, brutal conflict which is generally considered a localized prelude to the Second World War. The struggle between a recently established Republican government and reactionary forces led by Francisco Franco made manifest the broader political tensions and social concerns which characterized the interwar years. The lecture is particularly concerned with the use of propaganda by both Left and Right to galvanise support for their respective causes, within Spain and at an international level.
